


Dear President Pitts and Members of Council:

Bio-Sketch***R. LEANDRAS "BOBBY" JONES, II*****INTRODUCTION:**

Bobby Jones, a native of Durham, North Carolina, has resided in Atlanta for the past 28 years where he is President of his own design and construction management firm. He was previously employed by the internationally renown architectural firm, John Portman and Associates, Inc. as a Project Director and Vice President-Managing Associate. He and his wife, the former Elizabeth Ray "Penny" Scott, are parents to Allison Elizabeth (16 years old) and Harriston Andrew (12 years old). Bob is a 1970 alumnus of Howard University's School of Engineering and Architecture where he pursued the Bachelor of Architecture Degree majoring in Design and Construction.

Bobby Jones is a community activist and donates his time and talents to the community through his many activities both professionally and socially. His contributions are exemplified in his service of commitment to his church, his fraternity, the Atlanta community at large as well as his devotion to his family.

PROFESSIONAL ACHIEVEMENTS:

Professionally, Bob is the President & CEO of *THE RLJ/II GROUP*, his design and construction management firm. The firm has been retained to manage design and construction projects in southeast Georgia, South Carolina, Manhattan and the Atlanta area.

Prior to establishing his company Bob was employed at John Portman & Associates. In the capacity as Project Director, he coordinated the master planning efforts which created a new campus for Albany State College in Albany, Georgia which was damaged during the July '94 floods. The investment of some \$ 67 million dollars in buildings and redefining the campus plan served to change the complexion and the perception of the college. In addition, he provided senior experience in developing the construction documents for a mixed-use development project in Kuala Lumpur. His delivery of services to the company's clients offered the opportunity to establish long relationships. Consequently, he continues to provide client services to the New York Marriott Marquis Hotel The Nederlander Organization (Broadway Producers), Pacific Development

Company (the managing company for Embarcadero Center, San Francisco), and Marriott Resorts Corporation.

COMMUNITY SERVICE:

Bobby's stewardship to his church, Antioch Baptist Church North, is highly visible. He chairs the Antioch's Budget Committee, an appointed position he has held for the past 17 years. He is an ordained Deacon and has served as Chairman of the Trustee Ministry. His church history of stewardship includes his appointment as Administrative Assistant to the Pastor for Development; having served as a member of both the Male Usher Board and the Male Choir; Building Manager for the Church; Assistant to the Pastor on Planning. This ministry of service expands to include assisting with the church's weekly food bank program where more than 15,000 pounds of food are distributed to the needy in the community.

Under the banner of Antioch Urban Ministries, Inc., Bob is the Director for Project Development managing the continuing renovation of the converted 9-story condominium building to a 128-unit apartment complex which houses the working homeless in downtown Atlanta: the renovation of property into transitional residences for men and women addicted to substance abuse; and the conversion of a motel into transitional housing for those homeless persons afflicted with HIV. He continues to coordinate planning for the renovation and construction of affordable housing in the English Avenue community in northwest Atlanta. He serves on the Board of Directors of the Bethursday Development Corporation that will develop and rehabilitate some 75 vacant properties in a 9 block area known as the English Avenue Superblock. Bob represents AUMI as the community partner in the development of the Northyards Business Park and serves as liaison to the Community Trust Fund.

Jones provides consultation to many minority and community-based organizations working with the building and zoning departments for projects such as The Walton, The Alpha Center, Head Start Program expansion efforts, and private elementary schools.

A former Eagle Scout, Bobby also serves as an advisor to Tiger Cub Pack 701 chartered at Romar Academy, a Assistant Scoutmaster for Troop 529 (Beecher Hills Elementary School) and participates in Eta Lambda Chapter's Scouting program for Pack and Troop Units 1070. An advocate for youth, Bobby appointed by East Point Mayor Patsy Hilliard to participate as a consultant to the Board of East Point Amateur Baseball League. He serves on the Board of Directors for the East Point Football Association and the Board of Directors of the East Point Police Athletic League.
