AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2000 (INTERGOVERNMENTAL GRANT FUND) BUDGET, DEPARTMENT OF THE MAYOR, BY ADDING TO ANTICIPATIONS AND APPROPRIATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$42,500.00 FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS GOVERNOR'S DISCRETIONARY FUND GRANT FOR KEEP ATLANTA BEAUTIFUL'S SCRAP TIRE CLEAN UP DAY; TO ASSIST THE MARTIN LUTHER KING MARCH COMMITTEE WITH THE NATIONAL MARCH OF CELEBRATION; TO ASSIST QUALITY LIVING SERVICES, INC. WITH THE CONVERSION OF A SWIMMING POOL INTO A THERAPEUTIC POOL AND A CLUBHOUSE INTO AN EDUCATIONAL FACILITY; TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO SIGN ALL NECESSARY GRANT AGREEMENTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta has received and the Mayor has accepted a \$42,500.00 Governor's Discretionary Grant for the purpose of providing funds to assist with Keep Atlanta Beautiful's Scrap Tire Clean Up, the Martin Luther King March Committee with the National March of Celebration, and Quality Living Services, Inc. with the conversion of a swimming pool into a therapeutic pool and a clubhouse into an educational facility; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of the City of Atlanta, Georgia has recommended increasing estimate receipts in the Intergovernmental Grant Fund by \$42,500.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

Section 1: That the 2000 (Intergovernmental Grant Fund) Budget, Department of the Mayor, be and is amended hereby as follows:



Section 3: That the City Attorney be and is directed hereby to prepare the appropriate contractual agreements for execution by the Mayor to be approved by the City Attorney as to form and that said contractual agreements shall not become binding on the City and the City shall incur no liability upon the same until such contract has been executed by the Mayor and delivered to the contracting parties.

Section 4: All Ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
