**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE *THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN APPROPRIATE CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH FULTON COUNTY TO CONDUCT A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE CITY OF ATLANTA TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 7, 2000 TO DETERMINE THE ISSUANCE OR NON-ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT BONDS AND TO APPROVE OR NOT APPROVE A NEW INCREASED HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION FOR RESIDENTS OF THE CITY WHO ARE 65 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER WHOSE INCOME DOES NOT EXCEED \$40,000; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.***

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 21-2-45(c) of the Georgia Election Code, the City of Atlanta may authorize Fulton County by ordinance to conduct elections and to perform any and all of the functions required; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta wishes to enter into a contract with Fulton County to conduct a Special Election for the City of Atlanta; and

**WHEREAS**, the City will pay for all expenses associated with said election.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:**

***SECTION 1*** That a special election to determine the issuance or non-issuance by the City of Atlanta Georgia, of General Obligation Public Improvement Bonds and to approve or not approve a new increased homestead exemption for residents of the City who are 65 years of age or older whose income does not exceed \$40,000, shall be called to be held in the City of Atlanta in conjunction with the state-wide General Election on November 7, 2000, by authority of separate ordinances.

***SECTION 2*** That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to execute an appropriate contractual agreement with Fulton County to conduct said Special Election in conjunction with the General Election on November 7, 2000.

***SECTION 3*** That the City shall pay to Fulton County all costs incurred in performing those functions which the City has requested Fulton County to perform in the election; said costs to be paid from and charged to the appropriate account.

**SECTION 4** That the Municipal Clerk be and hereby is directed to prepare an appropriate contract for execution by the Mayor to be approved by the City Attorney as to form.

**SECTION 5** That this contract shall not become binding on the City and the City shall incur no liability upon same until such contract has been signed by the Mayor and delivered to the contracting party.

**SECTION 6** That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and are hereby repealed.
