AN ORDINANCE TO IMPOSE A 90 DAY MORATORIUM ON THE ISSUANCE OF LIQUOR LICENSES IN THE SPI 9 BUCKHEAD COMMERCIAL CORE DISTRICT; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Whereas, SPI 9 District (the Buckhead Village area), due to a waiver of parking requirements, developed into an unplanned entertainment district with tremendous parking and traffic issues and,

Whereas, SPI 9 District has now been amended to require the same commercial parking requirements as apply throughout Atlanta and,

Whereas, the City of Atlanta has introduced a new zoning ordinance, Neighborhood Commercial Zoning, and the statement of intent for this new ordinance was incorporated into the amendments for the SPI 9 and,

Whereas, one of the potential provisions for this new zoning category is to provide for a balanced mix of retail that is supportive to the surrounding neighborhood, and

Whereas, SPI 9 has a proliferation of bars and not enough other retail to be supportive of the surrounding community and,

Whereas, the Public Safety Task Force recently received information from the Atlanta Police Department regarding elevated crime in the bar area of SPI 9 and,

Whereas, the Buckhead community is actively working toward a "visioning process" intended to result in new SPI 9 amendments.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA as follows:

SECTION 1.

That a ninety (90) day moratorium be adopted to cease the issuance of **new** liquor licenses in the area encompassing the SPI-9 Buckhead Commercial Core District for on premises consumption in the City of Atlanta.

Any potential applicant who has appeared at the City's Department of Planning, to obtain a date for appearance before the appropriate NPU within which the establishment for which the license is sought is located and any potential licensee who has filed an application with the Licenses and Permits Unit of the Atlanta Police Department to obtain a license to sell alcoholic beverages on or before the date this ordinance becomes effective shall not be considered a new applicant for purposes of this ordinance nor shall such person be precluded from continuing through the process for obtaining a license to sell alcoholic beverages pursuant to Chapter 10 of the City Code of Ordinances.

SECTION 2.

That during this 90 day period, the Mayor, the Atlanta City Council (particularly the Public Safety and Legal Administration Committee), the License and Permits Unit of the Atlanta Police Department and the License Review Board work in conjunction to propose a long range planning document for the issuance and renewal of on premises liquor licenses in the SPI-9 Buckhead Commercial Core District.

SECTION 3.

For purposes of this ordinance only, a license shall not be deemed as new if there shall have been a liquor license issued for the licensed premises within the previous 12 months.

SECTION 4.

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
