


WHEREAS, the Candler Park "Community Night Out" will be held in Candler Park on August 14, 2000 from 6:30 p.m. until 8:30 p.m. to acknowledge and celebrate the hard work that this community association has dedicated to public safety; and

WHEREAS, this event will demonstrate "neighborhood spirit" and community partnership with law enforcement and other agencies; and

WHEREAS, Major Carlos Banda, Zone 6 Commander of the Atlanta Police Department, has requested that the Atlanta City Council authorize an Atlanta Police Department helicopter to land in Candler Park to help educate citizens about reducing crime in their community,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:


Dear Councilmember Woolard:

This letter is on behalf of the Candler Park Neighbors Association, regarding their upcoming "Community Night Out", scheduled for Monday, August 14, 2000 from 6:30 p.m. – 8:30 p.m. This event will be held in Candler Park.

The "Community Night Out" is designed to acknowledge and celebrate the hard work this community association has done. They support the Public Safety Committee's efforts in recruiting fifty (50) volunteers to serve as block captains and encouraging the neighborhood watch concept. One of the committee's priorities is to educate citizens by reducing crime in the community. This event will demonstrate "neighborhood spirit" and community partnership with law enforcement and other agencies.

It is my desire to support the Candler Park Neighborhood Association efforts. Therefore, my staff per my instructions has made arrangements. See below:

- 1. Special Operations (SOS) will provide K-9 Unit, Drug Dog demonstrations, SWAT (highly trained tactical unit) equipment display, Mounted Patrol (Police ridden horses) highly skilled helicopter pilot (helicopter), skilled Bike Unit.**
- 2. Atlanta Fire Department will provide "Fire Safety House" (hands-on fire escape exhibit) for youth (5-11 yr. old.) "How to get out of a house on fire! A fire engine with a ladder (another hands-on experience for youth).**
- 3. Georgia Power Company will provide "Electric Vehicle" display (questions/answers).**




4. Entertainment incomplete at this time (there has been discussion of music, dance, etc.). A request for the Snowmobile has been submitted.

5. The Atlanta Children's Hospital promised to send information. They will not be able to attend unless there is a crowd of 500-600 people. Since we could not promise them that number, they will send information to be distributed to parents.

Councilmember Woolard, we have been instructed that in order for the helicopter to land in Candler Park, an appeal has to be presented to the city council for a "Special Resolution" approval. I feel the above information justifies "permission" to land the helicopter in Candler Park.
