

WILLIAMS AND WOODS FOR FC-6849-97B, PHYSICIAN SERVICES FOR ATLANTA PRETRIAL DETENTION CENTERS; ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SIXTYFIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$65,000.00). ALL CONTRACTED WORK SHALL BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM FUND, ACCOUNT AND CENTER NUMBER: 1A01 524001 I21004.

WHEREAS, the City did enter into a contractual agreement with Atlanta Internal Medicine, P.C., d/b/a Drs. Williams and Woods for FC-6849-97B, Physicians Services for Atlanta Pretrial Detention Centers; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of the Department of Corrections and the Director of the Bureau of Purchasing and Real Estate recommend approval of said renewal agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Director be and is hereby authorized to enter into Renewal Agreement No. 1 with Atlanta Internal Medicine, P.C., d/b/a Drs. Williams and Woods for FC-6849-97B, Physician Services for Atlanta Pretrial Detention Centers on behalf of the Department of Corrections in an amount not to exceed Sixty Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$65,000.00);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Director of the Bureau of Purchasing and Real Estate be and is hereby directed to prepare an appropriate renewal agreement for execution by the Director, to be approved by the City Attorney, as to form.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this renewal agreement shall not become binding on the City, and the City shall incur no liability upon same until such renewal agreement has been executed by the Director and delivered to the contracting parties.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that all revenue generated under this contract shall be deposited to Fund, Account, and Center Number: 1 A01 524001 I21004.

- A) Our firm is solely owned and operated by Drs. Joseph W. Williams and Benjamin E. Woods and is located at 730 Peachtree St. N.E., Atlanta, Ga. 30308
- B) Details of descriptive services :

I. Daily Sick Call

Daily sick call for inmates is of vital importance. Not only is the physician called upon to triage inmates properly for referrals to Grady Hospital but he is expected to treat inmates with very complex and involved medical conditions that require the expertise of seasoned physicians with broad and in-depth clinical knowledge and experience in dealing with such diseases as diabetes, hypertension, lung disease, heart disease, arthritis, and infectious disease just to name a few. It is also desirable that the physicians have extensive experience in Emergency Medicine since emergency situations do arise and quick and accurate medical decisions must be made to save life and limb. These decisions should not be made by unseasoned doctors but by very experienced ones. Additionally, experience and expertise in the delivery of health care in a correctional setting should be a prerequisite since these inmate patients tend to be unique and a varying approach to the delivery of their care is a must in order to deliver quality care in a cost effective manner with the least amount of exposure and liability to the City Of Atlanta. In summary, this aspect of performance is crucial.

II. Daily Medical Records Review:

This , too, is a vital part of inmate medical services. Since all inmates are not seen daily, their records must be reviewed for purposes of adjusting medication dosages and treatment plans in order to preclude adverse drug interactions, medication errors , etc. This is of particularly vital importance for adjusting a diabetics insulin for instance in order to assure that the inmate will not have an adverse insulin reaction which if undetected in this setting, could prove deadly. Furthermore, unnecessary and costly medication may be identified and discontinued or modified.

III. 24 Hour On- Call Responsibility


Needless to state, this too, is of vital importance in performance of this contract. The physician's duties extend far beyond his on-site responsibilities. The provider must demonstrate the ability to be available to the staff on a 24hour seven days a week basis to answer any questions that arise and help direct and resolve any and all medical problems that might arise. This, too, is a very sensitive and risk intensive area of care that only should be relegated to practioners with a proven track record and have demonstrated the ability to provide this service impeccably.

IV. Miscellaneous Duties

The physician under this contract must be able to provide continuing medical updates in terms of treatment modalities in the ever changing medical environment to staff and should be a proven team leader in this regard.

The foregoing summarizes, in essence, the required services under this contract. It should be pointed out that these very specifications that you have enclosed were actually written by us some one and one-half to two years ago and we have a proven track record in providing these very services to the City of Atlanta now for the past eight and one-half years. We are very proud of our accomplishments to date and are especially proud of the fact that to our knowledge during this time period, there have been no medical malpractice suits of merit filed against the city or us arising out of our rendering of services under this contract. It is our firm wish and desire to continue to render this high quality care in a very cost effective manner as we have done in the past.
