OF ATLANTA PRECINCT AND POLLING  
PLACES IN PRECINCTS 3R, 1D1, 1D2, 1T, 6C,  
6D, 4N1, 4N2, 4R, 4X1, 4X2, 2R, 8G, 10H, 10L,  
11M, 1S, 2D, 7E, 7J, 9J1, 9J2; and 10P AND  
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the 1993 Precinct and Polling Place Ordinance was adopted October 19, 1992, and Approved October 27, 1992, and;


**WHEREAS**, the Fulton County Board of Registrations and Elections has authorized various precinct polling place changes within the City of Atlanta due to certain conditions, primarily renovations and/or closings of certain facilities for various purposes, and;

**WHEREAS**, those changes are to precincts/polling places **3R, 1D1, 1D2, 1T, 6C, 6D, 4N1, 4N2, 4R, 4X1, 4X2, 2R, 8G, 10H, 10L, 11M, 1S, 2D, 7E, 7J, 9J1, 9J2, and 10P** and;

**WHEREAS**, the governing authority of the City of Atlanta, the Atlanta City Council believes that ratification of these previously authorized changes should be made by this Body.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** that the Atlanta City Council does hereby Amend the 1993 Precinct and Polling Places Adopted October 19, 1992, and Approved October 27, 1992, as required by Section 66-2 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances and Section 21-2-261 (a) of the Georgia Election Code and Rules of the State Election Board and as described by the attachments which are made a part hereof and identified as Exhibits A through N.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the Atlanta City Council does hereby ratify the previous authorization by the Fulton County Board of Registrations and Elections of precinct and polling places within the City of Atlanta as follows:



**SECTION 1.** Amend **Precinct/Polling Place 3R** by *permanently relocating* the Polling Place currently located at Grove Park Elementary School, 20 Evelyn Way, N.W., *to* Carter G. Woodson Elementary School, 1605 Bankhead Avenue, N.W., as indicated by attachment identified as Exhibit A.

**SECTION 2.** Amend **Precinct/Polling Place 1D1** and **Precinct/Polling Place 1D2** both currently located at **Lakewood Elementary School, 335 Sawtell Avenue, S.E.** by *eliminating and combining* said polling places to be re-designated as **Precinct 1T**, as indicated by attachment identified as Exhibit B. (See SECTION 14 for subsequent action regarding Precinct 1T)

**SECTION 3.** Amend **Precinct/Polling Place 6D** by *temporarily relocating* the Polling Place currently located at Brookvalley Church of Christ, 1146 Sheridan Road, N.E. *to* Morningside School, 1053 E. Rock Springs Road, N.E., and *temporarily joining* it with **Precinct/Polling Place 6C** also currently located at Morningside School, 1053 E. Rock Springs Road, N.E., as indicated by attachment identified as Exhibit C.

**SECTION 4.** Amend **Precinct/Polling Place 4N1** and **Precinct/Polling Place 4N2** both currently located at J.C. Harris Elementary School, 1444 Lucile Avenue, S.W. and **Precinct/Polling Place 4R** located at Community Church of Fellowship, 838 Cascade Avenue, S.W. and to *combine* **Precincts 4N1** with **Precinct 4R** to become **Precinct 4X1** to be split with **Precinct 4N2** which will become **Precinct 4X2**, as indicated by attachment identified as Exhibit D.

**SECTION 5.** Amend **Precinct/Polling Place 2R** by *relocating* the Polling Place currently located at D.H. Stanton High School, 970 Martin Street, S.E. *to* Ralph McGill Elementary School, 760 Martin Street, S.E., as indicated by attachment identified as Exhibit E.

**SECTION 6.** Amend **Precinct/Polling Place 8G** by *relocating* the Polling Place currently located at Campbell-Stone Apartments, 2911 Pharr Court Street, S.W. *to* The Cathedral Towers, Inc., 2820 Peachtree Road, N.W., as indicated by attachment identified as Exhibit F.

**SECTION 7.** Amend **Precinct/Polling Place 10H** by *relocating* the Polling Place currently located at Shaw Temple Baptist Church, 38 Hamilton E. Holmes Drive, N.W. *to* Peyton Forest School, 301 Peyton Road, S.W., as indicated by attachment identified as Exhibit G.

**SECTION 8.** Amend **Precinct/Polling Place 10L** by *relocating* the Polling Place currently located at West Manor Elementary School, 570 Lynhurst Drive, S.W. *to* Zion Hill Baptist Church, 815 Lynhurst Drive, S.W., as indicated by attachment identified as Exhibit H.



**SECTION 9.** Amend **Precinct/Polling Place 11M** by *relocating* the Polling Place currently located at D.M. Therrell High School, 3099 Panther Trail, S.W. *to* Kimberly Elementary School, 3090 McMurrays Drive, S.W., as indicated by attachment identified as Exhibit I.

**SECTION 10.** Amend **Precinct/Polling Place 1S** by *relocating* the Polling Place currently located at J.W. Dobbs Elementary School, 1965 Lewis Road, S.E. *to* Tull Waters Elementary School 660 McWilliams Road, as indicated by attachment identified as Exhibit J.

**SECTION 11.** Amend **Precinct/Polling Place 2D** by *temporarily relocating* the Polling Place currently located at C.W. Hill Elementary School, 286 Pine Street, N.E. *to* Bedford Pine Park, 400 Merritt Avenue, as indicated by attachment identified as Exhibit K. (See SECTION 16 for subsequent action regarding Precinct 2D)

**SECTION 12.** Amend **Precinct/Polling Place 7E** by *temporarily relocating* the Polling Place currently located at MARTA Office Building, 2424 Piedmont Road, N.E. *to* Peachtree Hills Recreational Center Gym, 308 Peachtree Hills Ave. and *temporarily joining* it with **Precinct/Polling Place 7J** also currently located at Peachtree Hills Recreational Center Gym, 308 Peachtree Hills Ave., as indicated by attachment identified as Exhibit L.

**SECTION 13.** Amend **Precinct/Polling Place 9J1** and **Precinct/Polling Place 9J2** by *temporarily relocating* the Polling Places both currently located at Perry Homes Recreation Building, 1041 Kerry Drive, N.W. *to* Dogwood Senior Center, 1953 Bankhead Highway, N.W., as indicated by attachment identified as Exhibit M.

**SECTION 14.** Amend **Precinct/Polling Place 1T**, temporarily located at Lakewood Elementary School, 335 Sawtell Avenue, S.E., by *relocating* it to its permanent location at Benteen Elementary School, 200 Casanova Street, S.E., as indicated by attachment identified as Exhibit N.

**SECTION 15.** Amend **Precinct/Polling Place 10P**, temporarily located at Harper-Archer High School, 3399 Collier Drive, N.W., by *relocating* it to its permanent location at Towns Middle School 760 Bolton Road, N.W., as indicated by attachment identified as Exhibit N.

**SECTION 16.** Amend **Precinct/Polling Place 2D** temporarily located at Bedford Pine Park, 400 Merritt Avenue, by *relocating* it to its permanent location at C.W. Hill Elementary School, 386 Pine Street, N.E., as indicated by attachment identified as Exhibit N.

**SECTION 17.** That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.







 ● EXISTING FACILITY


















