**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS,
RECREATION AND CULTURAL AFFAIRS, BUREAU OF PARKS,
TO MAKE A SECOND PAYMENT OF \$600,000.00 TO THE
ATLANTA PUBLIC SCHOOLS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION
OF THE MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. COMMUNITY CENTER.**

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta, Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs, Bureau of Parks maintains an outstanding working relationship with the Atlanta Public Schools ;and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta intends to construct the Martin Luther King Jr. Community Center on the site adjacent to the Atlanta Public Schools', John Hope Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Public Schools intends to completely renovate the John Hope Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Public Schools desires to provide additional library and recreation space for access to the children attending John Hope Elementary School, which would be available in the newly constructed Martin Luther King Jr. Community Center; and

WHEREAS, to achieve efficiencies of management and economies of scale, it is desirable to have only one contractor construct both projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta, Department of Parks Recreation and Cultural Affairs, Bureau of Parks will provide the children of John Hope Elementary with access to the library and recreation space at the Martin Luther King Jr. Community Center; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Public Schools agrees to contract for the construction of the Martin Luther King Jr. Community Center concurrently with the renovation of John Hope Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Cultural Affairs, Bureau of Parks has previously made a payment of 1,130,000.00 to the Atlanta Public Schools for the construction of the Martin Luther King Jr. Community Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA as follows:

SECTION 1: That \$600,000.00 shall be payable to the Atlanta Public Schools.
