RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SUBMIT TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT ATLANTA'S YEAR 2001 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN TO THE 2000-2004 CONSOLIDATED PLAN TO INCLUDE APPLICATION FOR THE TWENTY-SEVENTH YEAR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM, 2001 EMERGENCY SHELTER GRANT (ESG) PROGRAM, 2001 HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP (HOME) PROGRAM, AND THE 2001 HOUSING OPPORTUNITIES FOR PERSONS WITH AIDS (HOPWA) PROGRAM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City is required to submit to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development the Annual Action Plan to Atlanta's 2000-2004 Consolidated Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Action Plan includes project allocations from the 2001 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG); 2001 Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG); 2001 HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME); 2001 Housing Opportunities For Persons With AIDS (HOPWA); and

WHEREAS, in order to expedite and simplify the application and funding process, some proposals which met the two-year funding criteria adopted in the 2000-2004 Consolidated Plan are being recommended for Year 2001 and Year 2002 funding, contingent upon the availability of funding and continuing successful performance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

Section 1: That the Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to submit to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Atlanta's Year 2001 Annual Action Plan to the 2000-2004 Consolidated Plan, which includes application for the Twenty-Seventh Year Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program in the amount of \$12,072,000, the Year 2001 Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) Program in the amount of \$432,000, the Year 2001 HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME) in the amount of \$3,626,000, and the Year 2001 Housing Opportunities For Persons With AIDS (HOPWA) Program in the amount of \$3,610,000.


