A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT PRIVATE DONATIONS FOR THE ATLANTA PLANNING ADVISORY BOARD (APAB) LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE AND OTHER SPECIFIC APAB ACTIVITIES FOR OPERATIONAL SUPPORT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Atlanta Planning Advisory Board (APAB) will receive private donations for the training of Neighborhood Planning Unit leaders in the enhancement of citizen participation techniques and programs; and

WHEREAS, the donations received from (Exhibit A) the fund raising campaign and the training initiatives will be deposited into an interest bearing Trust Fund Account; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Planning will act as the principal administrator of the fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

Section 1: That the Mayor is authorized to accept donations for the support of the "APAB Leadership Institute" and other specific APAB activities.

Section 2: That the President and Treasurer is authorized to solicit funds on behalf of the APAB Board.

Section 3: That donations be limited to an annual maximum of \$2,500 from any individual donor or business.

Section 4: That the APAB Board will be required to follow the City's Purchasing Policies and Procedures as any other City entity.

Section 5: That all Revenue received from private donations shall be deposited into an interest bearing Trust Fund Account and Center Number: 3P02 664101 J53X0210QNA0.

Section 6: That all expenses to support the "APAB Leadership Institute" and other specific activities shall not exceed \$15,000.00 per calendar year of which 80% shall be expended within that same year to allow a maximum carryover of 20% of the highest fund accumulation during the current calendar year. Any funds in excess of the maximum carryover shall be re-allocated to the DPDNC budget for APAB.

Section 7: That Said funds shall be expended from Trust Fund Account and Center Numbers: 3P02 527010 Y61R0512QNA0, 3P02 527009 Y61R0512QNA0, 3P02 521105 Y61R0512QNA0, 3P02 527002 Y61R0512QNA0, 3P02 529001 Y61R0512QNA0.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is Authorized to execute all documents necessary to accomplish acceptance of the foregoing donations.
