FINANCE/EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

**A RESOLUTION TAKING THE BELOW STATED POSITIONS ON VARIOUS  
PIECES OF LEGISLATION PRESENTLY PENDING BEFORE THE 2001  
GEORGIA GENERAL ASSEMBLY**

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA,  
GEORGIA as follows:**

Section 1: That the following positions are hereby taken on the following legislation that is presently pending before the 2001 Georgia General Assembly:

**Senate Bill 169 by Senators Paul of the 40<sup>th</sup>, Price of the 56<sup>th</sup> and Ray of the 48<sup>th</sup>** to amend Georgia Code relating to an act to incorporate the City of Sandy Springs in Fulton County; to provide for a Charter for the City of Sandy Springs; to provide for a governing authority, election, terms, method of filling vacancies, compensation, qualifications, prohibitions, districts and removal from office relative to members of such governing authority

**OPPOSE**

**House Bill 574 by Representatives Wilkinson of the 43<sup>rd</sup>, Willard of the 44<sup>th</sup>, Millar of the 59<sup>th</sup> Campbell of the 42<sup>nd</sup> and Irvin of the 45<sup>th</sup>** to amend the Georgia Code relating to the incorporation of the City of Sandy Springs in Fulton County; to provide for a City Manager, a City Clerk, a Tax Collector, a City Accountant, and other personnel; to provide for incorporation, boundaries, and powers of the City; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes


