A RESOLUTION

BY FINANCE/EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FULTON COUNTY TO CONSIDER ADOPTING A MILLAGE RATE FOR TAX YEAR 2001 WHICH DOES NOT EXCEED THE ROLL-BACK RATE AS DEFINED IN O.C.G.A. §48-5-32.1(A)(9).

WHEREAS, ad valorem property taxes constitute a severe financial burden on many of our City of Atlanta homeowners; and

WHEREAS, that burden is most heavily felt among our elderly population and other homeowners who receive fixed incomes; and

WHEREAS, the process of gentrification is causing an increase in the tax burden of these citizens in certain City neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, for tax year 2001, more than half of all Fulton County properties have been reassessed usually resulting in valuation increases; and

WHEREAS, in order to offset this valuation increase so as not to result in a property tax increase, taxing authorities may "roll-back" their millage rates to a millage rate equivalent to the total net assessed value added by the reassessments; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta and the City of Atlanta Board of Education are proposing to adopt millage rates which do not exceed the roll-back rate as defined in O.C.G.A. §48-5-32.1(a)(9); and



WHEREAS, because of the foregoing concerns regarding property tax increases, the Atlanta City Council requests that all of the entities with the power to tax within the City of Atlanta, adopt a millage rate which does not exceed the roll-back rate.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA HEREBY RESOLVES as follows:

The Atlanta City Council hereby requests the Board of Commissioners of Fulton County to consider adopting a millage rate for tax year 2001 which does not exceed the roll-back rate as defined in O.C.G.A. §48-5-32.1(a)(9).

Be It Further Resolved that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Clerk and the Chairman **and all members** of the Board of Commissioners of Fulton County.
