**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 1993 CITY OF
ATLANTA PRECINCT AND POLLING PLACES
IN PRECINTS 6C, 6D, 8N, 8P, 7E, 7J, 10H & 10R
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the 1993 Precinct and Polling Place Ordinance was adopted October 19, 1992, and Approved October 27, 1992, and;

WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board of Registrations and Elections has authorized various precinct polling place changes within the City of Atlanta due to certain conditions, primarily renovations and/or closings of certain facilities for various purposes, and;

WHEREAS, those changes are to precincts/polling places **6C, 6D, 8N, 8P, 7E, 7J, 10H & 10R;**

WHEREAS, the governing authority of the City of Atlanta, the Atlanta City Council believes that ratification of these previously authorized changes should be made by this Body.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Atlanta City Council does hereby Amend the 1993 Precinct and Polling Places Adopted October 19, 1992, and Approved October 27, 1992, as required by Section 66-2 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances and Section 21-2-261 (a) of the Georgia Election Code and Rules of the State Election Board and as described by the attachments which are made a part hereof and identified as Exhibits A through D.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Atlanta City Council does hereby ratify the previous authorization by the Fulton County Board of Registrations and Elections and Dekalb County Office of Voter Registration and Elections of precincts and polling places within the City of Atlanta as follows:

SECTION 1. Amend Precinct/Polling Place **6D**, currently located as a joint precinct with 6C, at Morningside Elementary School, 1053 E. Rocks Springs Road, NE by *relocating* 6D to Morningside Baptist Church, 1700 Piedmont Road, NE as indicated by attachment identified as *Exhibit A*.

SECTION 2. Amend Precinct/Polling Place **8N** and Precinct Polling Place **8P** both located at Fire Station No. 23, 1545 Howell Mill Road. by *relocating* said polling places to The Water Works Lodge, 655 Green Street, NW., as indicated by attachment identified as *Exhibit B*.



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SECTION 3. Amend Precinct/Polling Place 7E currently located as a joint precinct with 7J, at Peachtree Hills Recreational Center, 308 Peachtree Hills Avenue, NE by *relocating* 7E to Sleep Inn Hotel, 800 Sidney Marcus Boulevard, as indicated by attachment identified as *Exhibit C*.

SECTION 4. Amend Precinct/Polling Place 10H currently located at Peyton Forest School, 301 Peyton Rd., SW by *dividing* said polling place and *creating a new precinct, 10R* with polling place to be located at London Town Houses Community Center, 308 Scott Street, SW, as indicated by attachment identified as *Exhibit D*.



PROBLEM: Precinct 8N was temporarily relocated to the above facility due to the management of the former facility, Mission Church of God, requesting that we relocate the precinct to another facility. Further, during the November 7, 2000 General Election, we received complaints from the voters regarding limited parking. There are no suitable facilities in the geographical area of Precinct 8N.

PROPOSAL: It is proposed that Precincts 8N and 8P remain joint and be relocated to the facility listed below. The proposed facility is much larger, accessible to the handicapped and is less than 1 mile away from the existing facility (see figures 08 and 08A attached). Voters will be notified by first-class mail 30 days before the next election.

PROBLEM: The polling place for Precinct 7E was temporarily relocated from the Marta Office Building due to renovations and was made joint with Precinct 7J to vote at the above facility. During the November 7, 2000 General Election, we received several complaints from the voters regarding limited parking and overcrowded conditions.

PROPOSAL: It is proposed that Precinct 7E be relocated to the facility listed below. The proposed facility is accessible to the handicapped and is approximately 2 miles from the existing facility and about 1 mile from the former facility, the Marta Office Building (see figures 09 and 09A attached). Voters will be notified by first-class mail before the next election.



PROBLEM: In accordance with Georgia Election Code Section 21-2-262 (a.1), some voters in Precinct 10H submitted a petition requesting that a precinct be created closer to their neighborhood. The voters feel that the current polling place is too far to travel. After surveying Precinct 10H, it was found that the voters located in the western portion of the precinct must travel approximately 2½ miles to the existing polling place.

PROPOSAL: It is proposed that Precinct 10H be divided and a new precinct be created to be designated Precinct 10R and located at the facility listed below (see figures 10 and 10A attached). The proposed facility is within a 1/4 mile of the voters in the proposed precinct and is accessible to the handicapped. **Voters will be notified by first-class mail 30 days before the next election.**




FIGURE 10
