A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN APPROPRIATE AGREEMENT WITH THE FAIRLIE-POPLAR IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT TASK FORCE FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PHASE II STREETScape IMPROVEMENTS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$800,000 IN FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT ASSISTANCE FUNDING WITHIN THE FAIRLIE-POPLAR STREETScape IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the Fairlie-Poplar Improvement District Task Force completed Phase I Streetscape improvements for the Fairlie-Poplar Improvement District; and

WHEREAS, the Phase I portions of the work were completed utilizing a combination of development impact fee appropriations and private matching fund sources, and were completed in a timely and efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, The City of Atlanta has received a Memorandum of Understanding from the State Of Georgia Department of Transportation committing \$800,000 in Federal Transportation Enhancement Funds specifically for this project; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Bureau of Purchasing And Real Estate granted a sole source designation with the Fairlie-Poplar Improvement District Task Force for the implementation of the Phase I portions of the work, and in the City's best interests, their service should be extended for the Phase II portions.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA

Section 1: That the Mayor is authorized to enter into an appropriate agreement with the Fairlie-Poplar Improvements Task Force for the implementation of Phase II Streetscape Improvements in the Fairlie-Poplar Improvement District in an amount not to exceed \$800,000.

Section 2: That all expenses be charged to and paid from fund /account/center 1B02 574001 M21F0519KX70.

Preliminary Scope of Work

Atlanta Memorial Park

Trail is proposed to link north Atlanta neighborhoods to the Atlantic Steel site, Georgia Tech, and Centennial Olympic Park. Project limits are from Northside Drive at Woodward Way to Ardmoor Drive.

Boulevard Drive Streetscape

The Boulevard Drive Streetscape project is an extension of the East Side Atlanta Trolley Trail project that was partially funded through Transportation Enhancement Activity funds prior to the Olympics. The Boulevard Drive Streetscape project includes the installation of an on-street bike route connecting to the East Side Atlanta Trolley Trail, the installation of historic markers, and the installation of trees, street lights, benches, and other streetscape elements. Project extends along Boulevard Drive between Warren and Norwood Avenue. The streetscape includes expanding the sidewalk, street lighting, street furniture, and landscaping. This project links to the Kirkwood Commercial District.

Cascade Mays Streetscape

Project includes improvement of streetscape and beautification along Cascade beginning at Delowe Road and continuing to the northern section of Willis Mill Road.

Cheshire Bridge Streetscape


Street improvements, landscaping, provisions for pedestrians and bicycles for Cheshire Bridge are from Lenox to Piedmont.

Fairlie-Poplar Streetscape

Fairlie-Poplar is centrally located in the City of Atlanta poised along major corridors such as Peachtree Street, Luckie Street and Techwood Drive, beautification and sidewalk improvements are included in scope.

Lakewood Heights Town Center Streetscape

This project is on the Jonesboro Road Corridor and Lakewood Avenue between Claire Drive and Lakewood Bridge at Milton Avenue and will include the beautification of the street and improvements for pedestrians and cyclists.



Metropolitan Parkway Streetscape

This project includes sidewalk improvements, intersection improvements, beautification and landscaping between Ralph D. Abernathy and the City's southern limits.

Moreland Avenue Gateway

This gateway includes repairs of sidewalks along Moreland from Ponce De Leon Avenue to Druid Place and the construction and landscape and gateway treatments.

Piedmont Avenue Streetscape

This streetscape includes the entrance enhancements of Piedmont Park as well as improvements along Piedmont Road.

Pryor Road Trail


Trail begins on Joyland Place north of Arthur Langford Park continues south through park crosses Thornton Road continues along the River and terminates at Claire Drive.

Southtowne Trail


Trail begins just south of South Bend Park and continues through newly acquired Trust for Public Land Property until the South River is reached. The trail will parallel the river southeast to Browns Mill Golf Course and encircle its grounds.

West End Trail

Trail is proposed along abandoned CSX Railroad right-of-way between Simpson and Pryor. It will be 4 miles in length and will connect the Ashview Heights, West End, and Adair Park and link the Atlanta University Center campuses to downtown and to the other areas along this route. This project will include pocket parks, hard surface trail, and landscaping.



