Lisa currently serves as a Senior Vice President with Cousins Properties, Inc. Her duties include government relations, marketing and community reinvestment.

Previously, Lisa worked in the health care arena for over 15 years. She has primarily served the clinician side of the healthcare table. She served as the Chief Administrator for Atlanta Women's Specialists in Atlanta, Georgia and this OB/GYN group was driven to one of the largest in Georgia during her tenure.
