

A RESOLUTION BY

CITY UTILITIES COMMITTEE

**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN APPROPRIATE CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH INDUSTRIAL FURNACE COMPANY FOR THE REPAIR OF THE EXISTING THERMAL MASS REDUCTION UNITS AND APPURTENANCES AT THE R. M. CLAYTON WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, WASTEWATER SERVICES DIVISION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,500,000.00). ALL CONTRACTED WORK SHALL BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM FUND, ACCOUNT, CENTER NUMBER: 2J27 573001 M52I202 19999.**

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to enter into an appropriate contract with Industrial Furnace Company, the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM), for the repair of the existing Thermal Mass Reduction Units and appurtenances at the R. M. Clayton Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta owns and operates the R. M. Clayton Wastewater Treatment Plant, on which there exists Thermal Mass Reduction Units which were installed in the mid-1970s, heat treat and reduce the volume of sewage solids for safe disposal; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has installed and provided for the operation and maintenance of these units which heat treat and reduce the volume of sewage solids for safe disposal, the units have been in service for approximately 32 years, and now needs to replace worn-out parts in order to continue to meet the demand to heat treat and safely dispose of sewage solids and to assure the continued usage and efficient operations of the plant; and

**WHEREAS**, Industrial Furnace Company (IFCO) is the original designer of the system as well as the original equipment manufacturer of the Thermal Mass Reduction Units and is uniquely qualified to perform the repair, manufacture and delivery, systems testing and over all functions of the units; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bureau of Purchasing and Real Estate has certified Industrial Furnace Company (IFCO) as the only company qualified to repair the Thermal Mass Reduction Units and appurtenances as contemplated by Section 2-1191 of the City Code of Ordinances; and


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA**, that the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contractual agreement with Industrial Furnace Company (IFCO) for the repair of the Thermal Mass Reduction Units at the R. M. Clayton Wastewater Treatment Plant in an amount not to exceed One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00). All contracted work to be charged to and paid from Fund Account Center Number: **2J27 573001 M52I20219999**.



**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Director of the Bureau of Purchasing and Real Estate be and is hereby directed to prepare an appropriate contractual agreement for execution by the Mayor, to be approved by the City Attorney as to form.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this agreement shall not become binding on the City and the City shall incur no liability upon same until such contract has been executed by the Mayor and delivered to the contracting party.

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that all contracted work shall be charged to and paid from Fund Account and Center Number: **2J27 573001 M52I20219999**.
