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A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE COOPERATIVE
EFFORTS OF THE DEKALB COUNTY AND FULTON
COUNTY BOARDS OF TAX ASSESSORS TO COMPLY
WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF STATE LAW IN
MAKING TIMELY ADJUSTMENTS TO THE
ASSESSMENTS OF HOMES IN ATLANTA-DEKALB FOR
YEAR 2002 CITY OF ATLANTA PROPERTY TAX
PURPOSES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council has recognized the inequity that has existed since 1999 between Atlanta-Dekalb and Atlanta-Fulton property assessments as they apply to property taxes for city services; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 309, passed in the state legislature in 2000, addresses this inequity by requiring the Dekalb County Board of Tax Assessors to take Fulton County comparables into consideration in determining assessments for city tax purposes for Atlanta-Dekalb properties; and

WHEREAS, the Dekalb County Board of Tax Assessors implemented this state legislation for the year 2001 through retroactive adjustments to Atlanta-Dekalb assessments for city tax purposes; and

WHEREAS, for 2002, the Dekalb County Board of Tax Assessors has requested comparable assessment data from the Fulton County Board of Tax Assessors by April 1; and

WHEREAS, if this data is received by that date and evaluated in a timely manner, the Dekalb Board of Tax Assessors will be able to avoid having to perform retroactive adjustments this year and will be able to provide the City of Atlanta with correct tax digest information before the City sets its millage rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Fulton County Board of Tax Assessors is requested to provide comparable property assessment information to the Dekalb County Board of Tax Assessors by April 1, in order to allow the Dekalb County Board of Tax Assessors to make any necessary adjustments to Atlanta-Dekalb property tax assessments in accordance with state law.
