I am confident that Ms. Robinson will serve the Commission on Aging with distinction. This communication is for purposes of courtesy.



Monna D. Carter Robinson was born at Grady Hospital to Wyann and Ruby Carter. She attended David T. Howard high school in Atlanta and went to nursing school. From a very young age Monna has been working in the community and with our youth. Monna has had a variety of professions including teaching, cooking, and nursing. She worked at the Royal Peacock and Jinkens Steak House where she was admired and recognized by all.



As a member of Butler Street Baptist Church for 30 years, she was instrumental in starting various community programs and also sang in the church choir. She is now a member of Big Bethel Methodist Church.

Monna's love for children is unending. While the teachers were on strike at M.L. King Middle school, Monna prepared lunch for the students and made sure they were fed. She was also instrumental in starting the 1st parenting class, which was developed to help parent's better work with teachers. She still serves on the parent teachers student association for her grandchildren.

Monna's social and political activism is widespread. She played a big roll in finding the first library for African Americans in the 4th Ward. She served on the Board for EOA and the Atlanta Housing Authority. She also served under Mayor Maynard Jackson as chairperson of the eldercare committee where she was instrumental in starting the Annual Senior Citizens Ball. Monna was appointed by Governor Harris to serve on the Silver-Haired Legislature, Fulton County Democratic Party. She still serves in this position under Governor Roy Barnes. Her other affiliations include the Fulton County Council on Aging and the Atlanta Task Force.

Since the early 30's Monna has been a member of the Elk's and VFW where she worked with different singers and bands that came to Atlanta. She is also a member of the ~~Masons~~, Capital Homes YWCA, Victory over Violence and Butler Street YMCA. *Carter Eastern Star*

In 1969, Monna started working with the National Council of Negro Women as a volunteer. She brought in numerous memberships and helped implement the National projects initiated by the former NCNW Southeastern Regional office. Monna joined the Atlanta section and served as chair of the Eldercare committee where she kept the section up-to-date with political and social issues that were affecting the elderly. She also distributed lunches to the volunteers at the Annual Black Family Reunion Celebration. Monna is now a NCNW life member.

Monna has 1 daughter, Katherine Carter Wade; 16 grandchildren, ²⁹26 great grandchildren, and 6 great great grandchildren. Monna continues to be an asset to the community and is well loved by all.
