Charles J. Kelley

Charles Kelley was born and raised in metropolitan Atlanta. He is a product of the Atlanta Public School System, and is a graduate of Morehouse College, where he received a B.A. degree in Economics in 1970.

His professional career began upon graduation from Morehouse, when he joined the management training program at the former Citizens & Southern National Bank (now Bank of America). During his career at C&S, he was elected a bank officer in 1973, becoming the third African-American bank officer employed by a large bank in the City of Atlanta.

In late 1973 he resigned his position and joined the Atlanta office of the Interracial Council for Business Opportunity (ICBO), a New York based minority business consulting organization. Initially employed as Capital Resources Officer, he was serving as Vice President/Executive Director of the Atlanta office when he resigned in 1978 to enter private business.

In August 1978 he achieved a life long dream when he became an entrepreneur, opening a small commercial printing company in northeast Atlanta, in Perimeter Center Office Park, now one of the largest office complexes in the region. After 17 years of self-employment, he sold his business in 1995, and accepted a position with the acquiring company, where he remained until May 1999. In June 1999 he joined his present employer, ProGraphics Communications, where he serves as Vice President, Sales.

He is actively involved in the community. He currently serves as chair of the Trustee Board at Cascade United Methodist Church and is also on the male usher board. He is a former president of the Atlanta Chapter of the Morehouse College National Alumni Association and the Adams Park Residents Association. He is a member of the 100 Black Men of Atlanta, the Atlanta Convention & Visitors Bureau, Morehouse Alumni Association, and the Atlanta Chamber of Commerce. He sits on the board of directors of the Butler Street YMCA; the University Community Development Corporation; and the Atlanta One Stop Capital Shop of the Atlanta Empowerment Zone. He has also served as a District Chair with the Atlanta Area Council, Boy Scouts of America. He is the recipient of the Silver Beaver Award, the highest award presented to a volunteer in Scouting, and the Whitney M. Young Service Award.

He and his wife Rhonda, a vocalist and religious music composer, are the proud parents of two college freshmen, Cicely and Jarrett.

In his spare time he enjoys music, golf, sports car racing (spectator) and reading.
