Her interests include environmental design and landscape ecology. Professional experience specializing in the planning and design of parks and multi-use trail systems include:

Developed a multi-use trail master plan document proposing 124 miles of greenway trails. The plan proposed an alternate transportation system for DeKalb citizens.
