AN ORDINANCE BY COUNCILMEMBER CLAIR MULLER  
AS AMENDED BY FULL COUNCIL

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR "TEMPORARY NO PARKING ANYTIME" SIGNS ALONG BOTH SIDES OF 6<sup>TH</sup> STREET, FROM PEACHTREE STREET TO WEST PEACHTREE STREET, BORDERING THE POST BILTMORE; UNTIL SUCH TIME AS A PARKING METER PROGRAM CAN BE DEVELOPED IN THE CITY OF ATLANTA, AND FOR OTHER PUPROSES.

WHEREAS, the POST BILTMORE is one of the finest multi-family units in downtown Atlanta; and

WHEREAS, parking is always a problem for downtown residents and their visitors; and

WHEREAS, a nearby office workers are using POST BILTMORE parking spaces all day and

WHEREAS, one-hour parking limits signs have already been posted in front of POST BILTMORE along West Peachtree, which has helped with the parking problem and has enabled police to issue parking tickets; and

WHEREAS, upon the completion of the road widening work associated with construction of the CVS Pharmacy at Peachtree Street and 6<sup>th</sup> Street will be changed from one-way to two-way traffic; and

WHEREAS, POST BILTMORE supports making 6<sup>th</sup> Street a two-way street, and in anticipation of this occurring in the fall, would like to see "temporary no parking anytime" signs posted now along both sides of 6<sup>th</sup> Street, as well as when 6<sup>th</sup> Street becomes two-way, *until such time as a parking meter program can be developed in the City of Atlanta.*

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

SECTION 1: That "temporary no parking anytime" signs be installed on both sides of 6<sup>th</sup> Street, from Peachtree Street to West Peachtree Street, which borders the POST BILTMORE located at 855 West Peachtree Street, Atlanta, GA 30308, *until such time as a parking meter program can be developed in the City of Atlanta.*

SECTION 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
