WHEREAS, on this day, terrorists attacked the World Trade Center in New York City and the Pentagon in the Nation's capital; and

WHEREAS, thousands of lives were lost in Washington, D. C. and New York City, as well as on United Flight 93 which crashed in Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, these events are indelibly etched in the memories of citizens worldwide, generally, and of the United States, specifically; and

WHEREAS, the United States of America must never forget this tragedy and celebrate the courage of those who gave their lives for this country; and

WHEREAS, cities throughout the nation and around the world are observing this disaster in various ways;

WHEREAS, a fitting tribute to these fallen persons would be to create a joyful sound in their remembrance on the first anniversary of their deaths.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA that area Houses of Worship be requested to ring their bells at **noon on Wednesday, September 11, 2002** in remembrance of those lives that were lost as a result of the terrorists' attack on September 11, 2001.
