AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2002 (INTERGOVERNMENTAL GRANT FUND) BUDGET, DEPARTMENT OF THE MAYOR, BY ADDING TO ANTICIPATIONS AND APPROPRIATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,022,601.00 FROM THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS EMERGENCY GRANT AND LOCAL ASSISTANCE GRANT FUNDS FOR SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER, THE CITY OF ATLANTA/OLD FOURTH WARD NEIGHBORHOOD, PROGRESSIVE HOPE HOUSE, MOREHOUSE COLLEGE, WEST FULTON FAMILY SUPPORT CENTER, KIDS IN DISCOVERY OF SELF, MORRIS BROWN COLLEGE, JERICHO ROAD PROJECT, VINE CITY HEALTH AND HOUSING MINISTRY, TRINITY HOUSE, SOUTHWEST YMCA, SOUTHSIDE CULTURAL AWARENESS, PIEDMONT PARK, REYNOLDSTOWN COMMUNITY, PITTSBURG COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION, NONPROFITS, INC., NATIONAL BLACK ARTS FESTIVAL, CITY OF ATLANTA/IVERSON PARK, GEORGIA COALITION ON HUNGER, COMMUNITY CARE, DAVID T. WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta has received a \$1,022,601.00 State of Georgia Emergency Fund and Local Assistance Fund Grant for the purpose of providing funds to Senior Citizens Center, The City of Atlanta/Old Fourth Ward Neighborhood, Progressive Hope House, Morehouse College, West Fulton Family Support Center, Kids in Discovery of Self, Morris Brown College, Jericho Road Project, Vine City Health and Housing Ministry, Trinity House, Southwest YMCA, Southside Cultural Awareness, Piedmont Park, Reynoldstown Community, Pittsburg Community Improvement Association, Nonprofits, Inc., National Black Arts Festival, City of Atlanta/Iverson Park, Georgia Coalition on Hunger, Community Care, David T. Howard National Alumni Association, Clark Atlanta University, City of Atlanta/Dunbar Neighborhood Center, Cascade

Section 2: That the Mayor be and is authorized to enter into an appropriate contractual agreement with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs in an amount not to exceed \$52,500 to assist adult day care for Senior Citizens Center, said funding to be paid from D11R0718K2C0.

Section 3: That the Mayor be and is authorized to enter into an appropriate contractual agreement with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs in an amount not to exceed \$4,800 to plant trees and cleanup graffiti for the City of Atlanta/Old Fourth Ward Neighborhood, said funding to be paid from N12P11B6K2C0.

Section 4: That the Mayor be and is authorized to enter into an appropriate contractual agreement with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs in an amount not to exceed \$150,000 to assist repair of patient elevator for Southwest Hospital, said funding to be paid from D11R1019K2C0.

Section 5: That the Mayor be and is authorized to enter into an appropriate contractual agreement with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs in an amount not to exceed \$25,000 for construction for Progressive Hope House, said funding to be paid from D11R1009K2C0.

Section 6: That the Mayor be and is authorized to enter into an appropriate contractual agreement with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs in an amount not to exceed \$25,000 to study status of Georgia's African American males for Morehouse College, said funding to be paid from D11R1010K2C0.

Section 7: That the Mayor be and is authorized to enter into an appropriate contractual agreement with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs in an amount not to exceed \$10,000 to contract for services for West Fulton Family Support Center, said funding to be paid from D11R1018K2C0.

Section 8: That the Mayor be and is authorized to enter into an appropriate contractual agreement with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs in an amount not to exceed \$25,000 to maintain office/staff to continue and promote organization for Kids in Discovery of Self, said funding to be paid from D11R1002K2C0.

Section 9: That the Mayor be and is authorized to enter into an appropriate contractual agreement with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs in an amount not to exceed \$125,000 for renovation of an apartment building for Morris Brown College, said funding to be paid from D11R0942K2C0.

Section 10: That the Mayor be and is authorized to enter into an appropriate contractual agreement with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs in an amount not to exceed \$15,000 to feed and shelter homeless for Jericho Road Project, said funding to be paid from D11R1003K2C0.

Section 11: That the Mayor be and is authorized to enter into an appropriate contractual agreement with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs in an amount not to exceed \$15,000 to develop total wellness programs for Vine City Health and Housing Ministry, said funding to be paid from D11P0141K2C0.

Section 12: That the Mayor be and is authorized to enter into an appropriate contractual agreement with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs in an amount not to exceed \$25,000 for service to homeless men for Trinity House, said funding to be paid from D11R0865K2C0.

Section 13: That the Mayor be and is authorized to enter into an appropriate contractual agreement with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 for the Brother to Brother and Sisters Only program for Southwest YMCA, said funding to be paid from D11R0125K2C0.

Section 14: That the Mayor be and is authorized to enter into an appropriate contractual agreement with the Georgia Department of Community Affairs in an amount not to exceed \$6,000 to purchase materials and supplies for Southside Cultural Awareness, said funding to be paid from D11R1001K2C0.


