A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A REVISED INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT (IGA) WITH DEKALB COUNTY TO CONTINUE TO SHARING THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION'S (FAA) AUTOMATED RADAR TERMINAL SYSTEM (ARTS) DATA WITH DEKALB COUNTY FOR USE AT DEKALB-PEACHTREE AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta implemented a Noise and Operations Monitoring System (NOMS) at Hartsfield Atlanta International Airport (the "Airport"), which includes the collection and analysis of Automated Radar Terminal System (ARTS) data; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta has operated such a system under its original Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the FAA since June 6, 1996; and

WHEREAS, the City revised its original MOA on or about February 22, 2000 to allow DeKalb County to share the FAA's ARTS data for use in its noise program; and

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2000 the City of Atlanta has entered into an IGA with DeKalb County, that outlines the relationship between the entities and sets limits on future liabilities ; and

WHEREAS, on or about February 6, 2002 the FAA issued Order 1200.22C mandating a revision of all existing MOAs, requiring that the existing Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Atlanta and the DeKalb County be modified to accurately reflect the provisions of the Order.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a revised IGA with DeKalb County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney be, and is hereby directed to prepare and finalize the IGA for execution by the Mayor.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the revised IGA shall not become binding upon the City of Atlanta until such agreements have been duly executed by the Mayor, attested to by the Municipal Clerk, and delivered to DeKalb County.
