A RESOLUTION BY
COUNCILMEMBER DEBI M. STARNES

A resolution authorizing The Georgia Alliance for Children and Councilmember Debi Starnes to utilize the Trolley Barn, without fee, as one of the twelve days reserved for exclusive use by the City, or other governmental agencies, pursuant to the agreement between the City and the Atlanta & Edgewood St. Railway Company.

WHEREAS, The Georgia Alliance for Children, is a non-profit agency that, would like the use of the Trolley Barn on Sunday, December 8, 2002, to host a fund-raiser.

WHEREAS, This fund-raiser is co-sponsored by Councilwoman Debi Starnes.

WHEREAS, The City's contract with the Atlanta and Edgewood Street Railway Company provides that the Company shall reserve, without fee, a minimum of 12 days annually for exclusive use by the City, or other governmental agencies approved by the City and that such dates and users shall be subject to approval by the Atlanta City Council; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows, that The Georgia Alliance for Children and Councilwoman Debi Starnes is hereby granted the use of the Trolley Barn, at 963 Edgewood Avenue, NE, Atlanta, Georgia, on Sunday, December 8, 2002; and that this facility shall be reserved without fee as one of the days reserved for exclusive use by the City, or other governmental agency, pursuant to the agreement between the City and the Atlanta and Edgewood Street Railway Company; and

BE IT RESOLVED, The Georgia Alliance for Children shall still be required to pay the standard cleaning fee, not to exceed \$85.00, to the Atlanta and Edgewood Street Railway Company.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Municipal Clerk forward a copy of this Resolution to the management of the Trolley Barn, for their records.
