A RESOLUTION BY PUBLIC SAFETY AND LEGAL ADMINISTRATION COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$200,000 FROM THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A VIDEOCAMERA TO RECORD RED LIGHT VIOLATIONS AT A HIGH ACCIDENT LOCATION IN THE CITY OF ATLANTA, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, Red light violations are frequently the cause of serious traffic accidents in the City of Atlanta, and

WHEREAS, Curtailing traffic light violations is critical to efforts by the Atlanta Police Department to reduce traffic accidents in the City of Atlanta, and


WHEREAS, The Georgia Department of Transportation presently has funding available for local governments to install video camera equipment to detect and record traffic light violations in an effort to reduce traffic accidents

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA

Section One: That the Mayor is authorized to apply for and accept funding from the Georgia Department of Transportation in the amount of \$200,000 to install a video camera at one high traffic accident location in the City to apprehend traffic light violators who contribute to traffic accidents, injuries and fatalities.

Section Two: That no match is required by the grantor, and the City will be required to fund costs not associated with purchase and installation of the video equipment.
