**AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT ANY
COMMERCIAL TRUCK TRAFFIC ON
CHESTER AVENUE, FROM FULTON
TERRACE, SE TO WYLIE STREET, SE; AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, Chester Avenue corridor from Fulton Street, SE to Wylie Street, SE has become predominantly residential and should not be subjected to the heavy commercial truck traffic that has been a part of the corridor's history; and

WHEREAS, Chester Avenue from Fulton Street, SE to Wylie Street, SE runs through a strictly residential area, the residents of which endure a steady stream of commercial trucks driving through their neighborhood on a daily basis, including dump trucks, cement trucks and semitractor trailers; and

WHEREAS, the appropriate traffic study has been conducted by the Bureau of Traffic and Transportation and supports the community's effort to prohibit these types of trucks; and

WHEREAS, pedestrians and property owners are unable to utilize Chester Avenue from Fulton Street, SE to Wylie Street, SE because of the commercial truck traffic, as they fear for their safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA as follows:

SECTION 1: All vehicles exceeding **30 feet in length, 18 tons in weight, or having more than six (6) wheels** (excluding buses) shall be prohibited from traveling on Chester Avenue from Fulton Street, SE to Wylie Street, SE, unless a vehicle fitting that description is **specifically having a point of destination** within the **residential** neighborhood with a manifest to prove it.

SECTION 2: A fine of \$500.00 shall be established for violators of this prohibition.

SECTION 3: The Department of Public Works/Transportation Services shall post prominent signs at both ends of Chester Avenue from Fulton Street, SE to Wylie Street, SE, with the signs to read:

- **"NO TRUCKS"** at the top of the sign.
- The center of the sign depicting the international symbol for prohibiting truck traffic.
- (which is a picture of a truck with a circle drawn around it and a line drawn through it).
- **"Over 30 ft. long, over 18 tons, or having more then 6 wheels"** at the bottom of the sign.



SECTION 4: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be hereby repealed.
