A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF ATLANTA/FULTON COUNTY LAND BANK AUTHORITY, INC. TO IMPLEMENT CD-2003-489 LAND BANK AUTHORITY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, this project was approved in the 2003 Annual Action Plan for CDBG Programs and this project is ready for implementation; and

WHEREAS, this project provides matching funds to Fulton County's contribution to staff the City of Atlanta/Fulton County Land bank Authority; and

WHEREAS, funding will allow the Land Bank to remain fully operational with staff members and accomplish the tasks of clearing titles and satisfying back taxes on delinquent properties for transfer to the city's providers of affordable housing; and

WHEREAS, to allow for increased production these properties received through this process will be used to provide affordable housing for low and moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, this project has been environmentally cleared as of February 21, 2003 and the contract shall be effective as of the clearance date.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into a contractual agreement with the City of Atlanta/Fulton County Land Bank Authority, Inc. to implement CD-2003-489 Land Bank Authority for an amount not to exceed \$161,718.00 to be paid from account **1B01 529002 Y46P0155A23A**.

SECTION 2: That the City Attorney be and is hereby authorized to prepare an appropriate contract agreement for execution by the Mayor, to be approved by the City Attorney as to form.

SECTION 3: That this contract shall not become binding on the City and the City shall incur no liability until such time as the contract has been signed by the Mayor and delivered to the contracting parties.
