AN ORDINANCE WAIVING SECTION 2-2 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA TO THE NAME MULTI-PURPOSE ROOM IN THE NEWLY CONSTRUCTED ADAMSVILLE NATATORIUM THE DR. WILLIAM "BILL" CLEVELAND MULTI-PURPOSE ROOM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the newly constructed Adamsville Natatorium is owned and will be operated by the City of Atlanta; and

WHEREAS, this facility is being dedicated to the citizens of the Adamsville and Dr. William "Bill" Cleveland is one of those outstanding community leaders that has distinguished himself from the rest; and

WHEREAS, this new facility has a Multi-Purpose Room that would be an appropriate way to acknowledge Dr. William "Bill" Cleveland contributions to the Adamsville community and a fitting tribute to his tireless efforts for the betterment of the citizens of Adamsville

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA as follows:

SECTION 1: That Section 2-2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Atlanta is hereby waived due Dr. Cleveland not meeting the age or death requirement.

SECTION 2: That the Multi-Purpose Room being built in the Adamsville Natatorium is hereby named the Dr. William "Bill" Cleveland Auditorium.

SECTION 3: This name change shall be effective upon approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 4: The appropriate City agencies, including but not limited to the Department of Administrative Services are hereby authorized to take such steps as necessary to comply with having the signage displayed in the referenced area changed.

SECTION 5: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be hereby repealed.
