**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM MIDTOWN BUSINESS ASSOCIATION, INC. ("MIDTOWN ALLIANCE") TO FUND THE CITY'S LOCAL MATCH COMMITMENT TO THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION IN CONNECTION WITH AN AGREEMENT FOR TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT ACTIVITIES, DATED JULY 21, 2002, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTION OF STREETSAPES ON PIEDMONT ROAD FROM THE INTERSECTION OF 12<sup>TH</sup> STREET TO THE SOUTH TO ONE BLOCK NORTH OF THE 14<sup>TH</sup> STREET/PIEDMONT ROAD INTERSECTION ALONG THE WESTERN EDGE OF PIEDMONT PARK; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta desires to obtain the maximum benefit from funding made available for Transportation Enhancement Activities in connection with certain qualified and approved projects which provide a match of four federal dollars for every dollar contributed by a local government; and

**WHEREAS**, matching funding for certain projects may only be available for a limited period of time before the federal matching funds may be subject to program changes and/or allocation to other programs; and

**WHEREAS**, a project identified by the Atlanta Regional Commission and the Georgia Department of Transportation as STP-000E (223) P.I. 771258 ("Piedmont Edge") has been approved as eligible for \$260,000 in federal matching funds if the City can provide \$65,000 in matching funds to the Georgia Department of Transportation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Piedmont Edge project will construct streetscapes on Piedmont Road from the intersection of 12<sup>th</sup> Street to the south to one block north of the 14<sup>th</sup> Street/Piedmont Road intersection along the western edge of Piedmont Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has previously entered into a Agreement for Transportation Enhancement Activities dated July 21,2002 with the Georgia Department of Transportation allowing the City to utilize the funding presently programmed to the Piedmont Edge project but the City currently lacks the funding needed for the local government match; and



**WHEREAS**, the Midtown Business Association, Inc. ("Midtown Alliance") has committed to the City that it is willing to enter into a contractual arrangement with the City to provide funding to the City in the amount sufficient to allow the City utilize the funding presently programmed to Piedmont Edge Improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to accept this funding grant from Midtown Alliance to meet the City's commitment to GDOT;

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Council of the City of Atlanta as follows:

**Section 1.** That the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Atlanta, an agreement with Midtown Alliance which will specify the terms on which Midtown Alliance will provide and the City will accept funding for the City's local match portion of STP-000E (223) P.I. No. 771258 provided however that any terms which bind the City to repayment of all or any part of the grant from Midtown Alliance must be approved by further action of this Council. After the signing of the agreement, no further action of the Council is necessary before the grant can be accepted and work can begin on the projects.

**Section 2.** The City Attorney be and hereby is directed to negotiate, prepare and/or review the agreements necessary to effect the intent of this resolution provided that such agreements are in compliance with the conditions set forth herein.
