



**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT HOMELAND SECURITY FUNDING FROM THE GEORGIA EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY FOR EQUIPMENT TO ENHANCE THE RESPONSE OF THE ATLANTA POLICE DEPARTMENT TO TERRORIST ATTACKS, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, following the terrorist attacks on America on September 11, 2001, there has been a heightened awareness of the need to prevent and to effectively respond to future potential attacks, and

**WHEREAS**, the United States Office of Domestic Preparedness has made available to the State of Georgia, grant funds to be passed through to local governments to equip responders to safely and effectively respond to terror attacks, and

**WHEREAS**, the Atlanta Police Department has identified specific equipment needs to more effectively respond to terror attacks and to protect police personnel who work at the scene of such attacks, and

**WHEREAS**, The United States Office of Domestic Preparedness has identified the Georgia Emergency Management Authority as the state agency to administer federal funds for Homeland Security needs

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA**

**Section 1:** that the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for and accept Homeland Security funding for police equipment in the amount of approximately \$2,581,753 to enhance the ability of the Atlanta Police Department to respond to terror attacks in the City of Atlanta.

**Section 2:** that the Mayor is hereby authorized to sign and execute all related grant agreements.




