



SUBSTITUTE RESOLUTION BY
TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE

AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION OF THE TERM OF FC-6959-98, THE ADVERTISING CONCESSION OPERATING AGREEMENT WITH TRANSPORTATION MEDIA, INC. ON A MONTH-TO-MONTH BASIS NOT TO EXCEED SIX (6) MONTHS UNTIL A NEW CONTRACT BECOMES EFFECTIVE; ALL TERMS AND CONDITIONS SHALL REMAIN THE SAME.

WHEREAS, the contract for FC-6959-98, Advertising Concession Operating Agreement, for the operation of the advertising concession at Hartsfield Atlanta International Airport, covering advertising and hotel reservation boards in various locations in the Terminal Buildings and concourses under a concession operating agreement; and

WHEREAS, Transportation Media, Inc. is currently the contractor for FC-6958-98, the Advertising Concession Operating Agreement, which has expired; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta (the "City"), did advertise for new proposals under FC-7430-02, Concession Advertising and proposals were received August 21, 2002; and


WHEREAS, the solicitation for FC-7430-02, Concession Advertising is currently under protest and, therefore, the new solicitation is on hold until the protest is resolved; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the continuation of the services under the existing contract on a month-to-month basis until a new contract becomes effective or until the services are cancelled by the City upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to Transportation Media, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that FC-6959-98, the Advertising Concession Operating Agreement with Transportation Media, Inc. be extended on a month-to-month basis not to exceed six (6) months until a new contract becomes effective or until it is cancelled by the City upon thirty (30) days prior written notice to Transportation Media, Inc., with all other terms and conditions thereof to continue in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all revenues generated under this contract shall be deposited into the appropriate Fund Account and Center numbers.
