AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A MASTER INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT WITH U.S. COMMUNITIES, A NON-PROFIT INSTRUMENTALITY OF GOVERNMENT THAT HELPS PUBLIC AGENICIS REDUCE THE COST OF PURCHASED GOODS BY COMBINING THE PURCHASING POWER OF PUBLIC AGENCIES NATIONWIDE, FOR THE CITY OF ATLANTA TO BE DESIGNATED AS A PARTICIPATING PUBLIC AGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta (the "City") desires to enter into an Master Intergovernmental Purchasing Agreement with U.S. Communities to be designated as a Participating Public Agency that will allow the City to purchase a variety of goods, products and services made available through U.S. Communities based on the same terms, conditions and pricing as the Lead Public Agency, subject to any applicable City ordinances and the laws of the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, U. S. Communities is a public procurement unit; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 2-1602 and 2-1604 of the Procurement and Real Estate Code of the City, which authorizes cooperative purchasing agreements between governmental agencies and public procurement units, the City desires to enter into an Master Intergovernmental Purchasing Agreement with U.S. Communities to be designated as a Participating Public Agency; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Procurement Officer has recommended that the Master Intergovernmental Purchasing Agreement be executed.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to enter into an Master Intergovernmental Purchasing Agreement with U. S. Communities to be designated as a Participating Public Agency that will allow the City to purchase a variety of goods, products and services made available through U.S. Communities based on the same terms, conditions and pricing as the Lead Public Agency, subject to any applicable City ordinances and the laws of the State of Georgia.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Procurement Officer be and is hereby directed to prepare an appropriate contractual agreement to be approved by the City Attorney as to form for execution by the Mayor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this contractual agreement shall not become binding on the City, and the City shall incur no liability upon same until the contract has been executed by the Mayor and delivered to the contracting party.
