AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF LICENSES FOR THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2004 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2004; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta has been and continues to be a burgeoning international city and destination for visitors from throughout the region, nation and world; and

WHEREAS, because of this destination status, the City of Atlanta has developed a vibrant and successful nightlife culture; and

WHEREAS, this vibrant nightlife culture in the City of Atlanta is manifested and supported by a high concentration of nightclubs and stores licensed to sell alcohol; and

WHEREAS, the regulation and enforcement of the city's alcohol licensing code requires substantial manpower and monetary resources; and

WHEREAS, the proliferation of establishments contribute to a myriad of problems, including, but not limited to, traffic congestion, lack of police visibility and enforcement, and crowd control; and

WHEREAS, it is the belief of the Council that the sale of beer and wine by the package between the hours of midnight and 8:00 a.m. contributed greatly to the rise of drunk and disorderly crimes, assaults, illegal cruising and other criminal activity; and

WHEREAS, the Atlanta City Council is dedicated to providing the resources necessary to ensure the safety and welfare of Atlanta's citizens and its visitors; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that a comprehensive review be done of the City's zoning and alcoholic licensing code.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA as follows:

Section 1: Any person granted a license for the sale of alcoholic beverages pursuant to Section 10-48 or 10-106 of the Code during the calendar year 2004 shall be issued effective only for the period of January 1, 2004 through March 31, 2004.



Section 2: All annual fees for alcohol licenses issued shall be paid, prorated in proportion to the length of the license accordingly.

Section 3: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict are hereby waived for this instance only.
