**AN ORDINANCE BY THE COMMITTEE ON COUNCIL
AS AMENDED BY THE ATLANTA CITY COUNCIL**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2001 CITY OF ATLANTA
PRECINCT AND POLLING PLACES IN PRECINCTS 01C, 01P1,
01P2, 05L, 06J, 07F AND 08C AS A RESULT OF CLOSINGS OR
RENOVATION COMPLETIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the 2001 Precinct and Polling Place Ordinance, dated October 24, 2001, was adopted November 5, 2001, and;

WHEREAS, such Precinct and Polling Place Ordinance has previously been amended by action of the City Council on May 20, 2002; July 15, 2002; September 3, 2002; October 21, 2002; November 18, 2002; September 15, 2003; October 20, 2003; February 13, 2004; April 19, 2004; and July 19, 2004.

WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board of Registration and Elections and the Fulton County Board of Commissioners has authorized and approved precinct changes to Precincts/Polling Places 01C, 01P1, 01P2, 06J, 07F, and 08C as a result of closings or renovation completions and;

WHEREAS, the DeKalb County Board of Registrations and Elections and the DeKalb County Board of Commissioners has authorized and approved a precinct change to Precinct/Polling Place *05L* as a result of closing and relocation and;

WHEREAS, all affected voters will be notified of these changes by the Fulton County Office of Registration and Elections and the DeKalb County Office of Registration and Elections accordingly, and;

WHEREAS, the governing authority of the City of Atlanta, the Atlanta City Council believes that ratification of these previously authorized changes should be made by this Body.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Atlanta City Council does hereby ratify the previous authorization and approval by the Fulton County Board of Registration and Elections and the Fulton County Board of Commissioners of the precinct changes to Precincts/Polling Places 01C, 01P1, 01P2, 06J, 07F, and 08C as a result of closings or renovation completions, all within the City of Atlanta and;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Atlanta City Council does hereby ratify the previous authorization and approval by the DeKalb County Board of Registration and Elections and the DeKalb County Board of Commissioners of a precinct change to Precinct/Polling Place *05L* as a result of closing and relocation, within the City of Atlanta and;

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that the Atlanta City Council does hereby Amend the 2001 Precinct and Polling Place Ordinance, dated October 24, 2001, and Adopted November 5, 2001 which was codified as Section 66-2 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances and adopted by reference, by adding the recent changes to Precincts/Polling Places 01C, 01P1, 01P2, *05L*, 06J, 07F, AND 08C as a result of the closings or renovation completions all of which are reflected or incorporated in the October 4, 2004 Revision to the 2001 Precinct and Polling Place Ordinance identified as Attachment I to this ordinance, with certain particular changes described by the further attachments identified as Exhibits A, B, *C, D, E and F*; all being made a part hereof and noted as follows:




SECTION 1. To amend Precinct/Polling Place 01C located at Lakewood Heights Elementary School, 335 Sawtell Avenue, South East by relocating said Precinct to Church of Greater Works, 1800 Jonesboro Road, South East, due to the closing of the voting facility and the Atlanta Board of Education's consequent request that the precinct be relocated. The proposed facility is accessible to the handicapped and is approximately 1 mile away from the existing facility; as indicated by the attachment identified as Exhibit A, (Pages 1-3). Voters will be notified of their new voting location by first-class mail 30 days before the next election.

SECTION 2. To amend Precincts/Polling Places 01P1 and 01P2 located at Carver High School, 1965 Lewis Road, South East by relocating said Precincts/Polling Places 01P1 and 01P2 to Bible Way Ministries, 894 Constitution Road, South East, due to the closing of the voting facility and the Atlanta Board of Education's consequent request that precincts be relocated. The proposed facility is accessible to the handicapped, is more centrally located to the majority of the voters and is approximately 1 mile away from the existing facility; as indicated by the attachment identified as Exhibit A, (Pages 1-2). Voters will be notified of their new voting location by first-class mail 30 days before the next election.

SECTION 3. *To amend Precinct/Polling Place 05L located at Gartha B. Peterson Elementary School, 1757 Mary Dell Avenue, South East by relocating said Precinct to Burgess - Peterson Elementary School, 480 Clifton Street, South East (in Atlanta/DeKalb) due to the closing of the voting facility and the consequent relocation and boundary line change of Precinct/Polling Place 05L. The precinct boundary line was moved to incorporate Burgess - Peterson Elementary School which is located outside the existing precinct boundary lines; as indicated by the attachment identified as Exhibit C, (Pages 1-2). Voters will be notified of their new voting location by first-class mail 30 days before the next election.*

SECTION 4. To amend Precinct/Polling Place 06J temporarily located at Grace Lutheran Church, 1155 North Highland Avenue, North East by relocating said Precinct to its permanent voting facility at Inman Middle School, 774 Virginia Ave, North East, due to renovation completions at that location. The proposed facility is accessible to the handicapped and is approximately 1 mile away from the existing facility; as indicated by the attachment identified as Exhibit D, (Pages 1-2). Voters will be notified of their new voting location by first-class mail 30 days before the next election.

SECTION 5. To amend Precinct/Polling Place 07F temporarily located at 2nd Ponce De Leon Baptist Church, 2715 Peachtree Road, North East by relocating said Precinct to its permanent voting location at Cathedral of Saint Philip, 2744 Peachtree Road, North East, due to renovation completions at that location. The proposed facility is accessible to the handicapped and is approximately 1/2 mile away from the existing facility; as indicated by the attachment identified as Exhibit E, (Pages 1-2). Voters will be notified of their new voting location by first-class mail 30 days before the next election.



SECTION 6. To amend Precinct/Polling Place 08C temporarily located at Sutton Middle School, 4360 Powers Ferry Road, North West by relocating said Precinct to its permanent voting location at Northwest Presbyterian Church, 4300 Northside Drive, due to renovation completions and unavailable at that location. The proposed facility is accessible to the handicapped, and is approximately 1 mile from the existing facility; as indicated by the attachment identified as Exhibit F, (Pages 1-2). Voters will be notified of their new voting location by first-class mail 30 days before the next election.

SECTION 7. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


