**A RESOLUTION CORRECTING RESOLUTION NUMBER 03-R-0286, HEREBY AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH WALDECK HARTSFIELD CORPORATION, RATHER THAN STEVEN WALDECK, ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF AVIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DESIGNING, FABRICATING, TRANSPORTING, AND INSTALLING AN ARTWORK FOR THE TRANSPORTATION MALL AT HARTSFIELD-JACKSON ATLANTA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AS PART OF THE AIRPORT ART PROGRAM, FOR A TOTAL COST TO THE CITY OF ATLANTA NOT TO EXCEED \$1,300,000.00, TO BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM FUND ACCOUNT CENTER NO. 2H21 576001 R21002; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the Atlanta City Council adopted Resolution 03-R-0286 on March 3, 2003, and the Resolution was approved by the Mayor on March 11, 2003; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution 03-R-0286, which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1, authorized the Mayor to execute a contractual agreement with Steven Waldeck for the design, fabrication, transportation and installation of an artwork for the Transportation Mall at Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport; and

**WHEREAS**, the entity that will create the artwork is called "Waldeck Hartsfield Corporation", not "Steven Waldeck", and therefore the contract for the design, fabrication, transportation and installation of an artwork for the Transportation Mall should be with Waldeck Hartsfield Corporation; and

**WHEREAS**, Resolution 03-R-0286 must be corrected so that Waldeck Hartsfield Corporation is named as the contracting party, but all terms and conditions of Resolution 03-R-0286 shall remain unchanged.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA**, that Resolution 03-R-0286 is hereby corrected such that any reference in Resolution 03-R-0286 shall be changed to "Waldeck Hartsfield Corporation", and the remainder of Resolution 03-R-0286 shall remain the same, such that the Mayor or her designee be and is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Atlanta a contractual agreement with Waldeck Hartsfield Corporation for designing, fabricating, transporting and installing an artwork for the Transportation Mall at Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport as part of the Airport Art Program, for a total cost to the City of Atlanta not to exceed \$1,300,000.00, to be charged to and paid from Fund Account and Center number 2H21 576001 R21002.

A RESOLUTION

BY TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HER DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH ARTIST STEVEN WALDECK THAT SHALL COMMISSION HIS SERVICES FOR THE PURPOSE OF DESIGNING, FABRICATING, TRANSPORTING, AND INSTALLING AN ARTWORK FOR THE TRANSPORTATION MALL AT HARTSFIELD ATLANTA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AS PART OF THE AIRPORT ART PROGRAM, FOR A TOTAL COST TO THE CITY OF ATLANTA NOT TO EXCEED \$1,300,000.00, TO BE CHARGED TO AND PAID FROM FUND ACCOUNT CENTER NO. 2H21 576001 R21002; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta's Airport Art Program helps to humanize, invigorate, and beautify the airport environment by providing museum quality art experiences for the millions of passengers from around the world who pass through the airport annually; and

**WHEREAS**, a first-rate Airport Art Program provides an excellent opportunity for Hartsfield Atlanta International Airport ("Airport") to spread out a spectacular welcome mat befitting Atlanta's stature as an international, Olympic city; and

**WHEREAS**, the Airport Art Program serves as a soothing and enjoyable counterpoint to the sprawling, bustling airport environment, where passengers are often stressed, stalled or bored; and

**WHEREAS**, travelers to Atlanta should feel good about the time they spend in the Airport, and the Airport Art Program helps them to take away positive memories of their Atlanta travel experience; and

**WHEREAS**, the City utilized a Request for Proposals process to select the artist. Specifically, this artist was selected by a peer review panel, through a national Call for Artists process that involved approximately 1,000 artists, to create a original artwork specifically for the pedestrian corridor between Concourses A and B in the Transportation Mall; and

**WHEREAS**, artist Steven Waldeck was selected to create a multi-sensory environment entitled "Flight Paths" for the Transportation Mall, in which the artist uses a concept that involves creating a forested environment that integrates high technology lighting and sound effects with a tree canopy that will be layered above the pedestrian corridor; and

**WHEREAS**, this artwork will be a wonderful addition to the Airport's public art inventory and will be displayed in a site that is highly visible, easily accessible to the traveling public, and a site that will greatly benefit from the inclusion of a beautiful, thought provoking artwork.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA**, that the Mayor be or her designee and hereby is authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Atlanta a commissioning



agreement ("Agreement") with the above said artist which shall contain substantially the following terms and conditions:

- (a) Steven Waldeck shall create and deliver a multi-sensory artwork substantially as described hereinabove, including design, fabrication, transportation, and installation at the Airport, in accordance with his formal proposal to the City dated 10/15/00, for a cost to the City not to exceed \$1,300,000.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the cost to the City under said Commissioning Agreement shall not exceed \$1,300,000.00 for the project, to be charged to and paid from Fund Account Center No. 2H21 576001 R21002.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Attorney be and hereby is directed to prepare said Agreement for execution by the Mayor.

**FINALLY RESOLVED** that said Agreement shall not become binding upon the City, and the City shall incur no obligation nor liability thereunder until the same has been signed by the Mayor and delivered to Steven Waldeck.



