**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 03-0-2212 BY ADDING A NEW SECTION 6 TO ESTABLISH A REDUCTION IN WATER AND SEWER RATES COMMENSURATE WITH ANY REVENUES REALIZED FROM THE MUNICIPAL OPTIONS SALES TAX; RENUMBERING ALL SUCCESSIVE SECTIONS ACCORDINGLY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted 03-0-2212 on January 5, 2004 and the Mayor approved 03-0-2212 on January 9, 2004, which ordinance amended Chapter 154 Article III, Division 3, Sections 154-111 and 154-112 (Water Rates and Charges) and Chapter 154 Article V, Division 3, Sections 154-276 and 154-277 (Sewer Rates and Charges) to increase the water and sewer rates for the City of Atlanta, Georgia to be charged all residents, premises and facilities served by the Water and Sewer System of the City; and amended Chapter 154 Article III, Division 3, Section 154-118 to enact a water and wastewater systems security surcharge for the City of Atlanta, Georgia to be placed on water billings for all domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta Water System to pay for the cost of providing security services and to put in place security infrastructure and upgrades; and for other purposes; and

**WHEREAS**, House Bill 709, effective April 23, 2004, authorized the City of Atlanta to call for the imposition of a Municipal Option Sales Tax (MOST); and

**WHEREAS**, this City Council did authorize and the Mayor did approve the call for the imposition of the MOST on May 7, 2004; and

**WHEREAS**, the citizens of the City of Atlanta would benefit from a substantial reduction in rates, as additional revenues are realized by the City as generated by the MOST.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council further mandated in Section 5 of 03-0-2212 that the rates be annually reviewed and accordingly revised and recalculated so as to reduced the rates for all metered customers in appropriate proportion to the extent that the City of Atlanta receives additional funds from the sources or achieves cost savings through valve engineering and rate refinement efforts.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council hereby seeks to restate and reaffirm it commitment to rollback the water and sewer rates as funds ate received from other resources.

**THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA HEREBY ORDAINS**

**SECTION 1:** that Ordinance 03-0-2212 be amended by adding a new Section 6 to read as follows:


**SECTION 6:** that in the event that the City of Atlanta is successful in the passage and imposition of a Municipal Options Sales Tax (MOST), as provided for under House Bill 709, the revenues generated and received from the one per cent (1%) sales tax shall be applied to reduce the City of Atlanta's water and sewer rate structure on a dollar for dollar basis.

**SECTION 2:** That the remaining successive provisions of Ordinance 03-0-2212 be renumbered accordingly.

SECURITY SURCHARGE FOR THE CITY OF  
ATLANTA, GEORGIA TO BE PLACED ON WATER  
BILLINGS FOR ALL DOMESTIC, COMMERCIAL,  
INDUSTRIAL AND OTHER USERS OF THE CITY OF  
ATLANTA WATER SYSTEM TO PAY FOR THE COST  
OF PROVIDING SECURITY SERVICES AND TO PUT IN  
PLACE SECURITY INFRASTRUCTURE AND UPGRADES;  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS** the City of Atlanta, pursuant to its charter, has the responsibility of providing water and sewer service to its citizens, corporate customers and others outside the corporate boundaries of the City on both a retail and wholesale basis; and

**WHEREAS**, the City's water and sewer system is aging which has resulted in water main breaks and leaks and sewerline overflows; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to upgrade, improve and expand the system to protect the public's health and welfare and to serve their needs; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1998 and 1999 the City agreed to Consent Agreements with the EPA and the State to complete specified system improvements within a stated period of time; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost of these improvements, estimated at \$3 billion over the next five years, are such that resources are not available for construction within the existing water and sewer revenue stream; and



WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have, after extensive research and analysis, concluded that to maintain and upgrade the water treatment and distribution system and wastewater treatment and collection system to meet federal and state regulations and the future demands of economic growth in the City, a major program of capital improvements had to be initiated; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for water and sewer rate increases to be implemented to provide continued funding so that the capital improvement program can be completed within the period agreed to in the Consent Agreements with the EPA and State; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and the City Council to minimize to the extent possible the impact of rate increases on ratepayers and implement a rate structure that maintains affordability and promotes water conservation through the implementation of a graduated rate structure; and

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2002, the Public Health Security and Bioterrorism Preparedness and Response Act of 2002 (Bioterrorism Act) was signed into public law (P.L. 107-188) by the 107th Congress; and

WHEREAS, Title IV of this Act amends the Safe Drinking Water Act and outlines actions which community water systems and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) must take to improve the security of the nation's drinking water and wastewater infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta, pursuant to the Safe Drinking Water Act and Public Health Security and Bioterrorism Preparedness and Response Act, has the responsibility to conduct a vulnerability assessment of its treatment and water works; to implement security enhancements to reduce vulnerabilities identified in a vulnerability assessment; and to implement additional security enhancements to reduce vulnerabilities identified in a vulnerability assessment; and

WHEREAS, the City has conducted a vulnerability assessment and has concluded that to upgrade the security of the City of Atlanta water treatment and distribution system and wastewater treatment and collection system to meet federal and state regulations, a major program of security and capital improvements had to be initiated; and

WHEREAS, the City has an interest in encouraging its citizens to conserve its water resources and to promote conservation through the water and sewer rate structure; and

WHEREAS, the projected cost for the City of Atlanta water security system upgrade totals over \$28 Million; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta intends to provide funds through the creation of a security surcharge to pay for federally mandated security improvements to the City of Atlanta water treatment and distribution system and wastewater treatment and collection system facilities.



**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:** that Chapter 154, Article III, Division 3 (Water Rates, Charges, and Related Matters), Section 154-111 and 154-112 be amended to increase water rates as follows:

That the City of Atlanta water rate structure will include a graduated schedule of rates conditional on usage levels for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system, so as to encourage and promote conservation among all users.

They are as follows:

In-City water rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system using three hundred cubic feet or less shall be \$1.93 and \$2.33 for Outside-City water users beginning on and after January 1, 2004, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 10%.

In-City water rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system using more than three hundred cubic feet and less than seven hundred cubic feet shall be \$2.21 and \$2.67 for Outside-City water users beginning on and after January 1, 2004, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 26%.

In-City water rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system using seven hundred cubic feet or more shall be \$2.54 and \$3.07 for Outside-City water users beginning on and after January 1, 2004, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 45%.

In-City water rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system using three hundred cubic feet or less shall be \$2.12 and \$2.56 for Outside-City water users beginning on and after January 1, 2005, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 10%.

In-City water rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system using more than three hundred cubic feet and less than seven hundred cubic feet shall be \$2.76 and \$3.34 for Outside-City water users beginning on and after January 1, 2005, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 25%.

In-City water rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system using seven hundred cubic feet or more shall be \$3.63 and \$4.39 for Outside-City water users beginning on and after January 1, 2005, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 43%.



In-City water rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system using three hundred cubic feet or less shall be \$2.33 and \$2.82 for Outside-City water users beginning on and after January 1, 2006, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 10%.

In-City water rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system using more than three hundred cubic feet and less than seven hundred cubic feet shall be \$3.23 and \$3.91 for Outside-City water users beginning on and after January 1, 2006, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 17%.

In-City water rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system using seven hundred cubic feet or more shall be \$4.28 and \$5.18 for Outside-City water users beginning on and after January 1, 2006, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 18%.

In-City water rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system using three hundred cubic feet or less shall be \$2.56 and \$3.10 for Outside-City water users beginning on and after January 1, 2007, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 10%.

In-City water rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system using more than three hundred cubic feet and less than seven hundred cubic feet shall be \$3.59 and \$4.34 for Outside-City water users beginning on and after January 1, 2007, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 11%.

In-City water rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system using seven hundred cubic feet or more shall be \$4.75 and \$5.75 for Outside-City water users beginning on and after January 1, 2007, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 11%.

In-City water rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system using three hundred cubic feet or less shall be \$2.76 and \$3.35 for Outside-City water users beginning on and after January 1, 2008, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 8%.

In-City water rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system using more than three hundred cubic feet and less than seven hundred cubic feet shall be \$3.88 and \$4.69 for Outside-City water users beginning on and after January 1, 2008, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 8%.

In-City water rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system using seven hundred cubic feet or more shall be \$5.23 and \$6.33 for Outside-City water users beginning on and after January 1, 2008, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 10%.



**SECTION 2:** that Chapter 154, Article V, Division 3 (Sewer Rates and Charges), Sections 154-276 and 154-277 be amended to increase monthly billed sewer rates as follows:

That the City of Atlanta sewer rate structure will be \$4.90 per hundred cubic feet for the first three hundred cubic feet for sewer users beginning on and after January 1, 2004, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 10%.

That sewer rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system shall be \$5.61 per hundred cubic feet for more than three hundred of cubic feet and less than seven hundred cubic feet beginning on and after January 1, 2004, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 26%.

That sewer rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system shall be \$6.45 per hundred cubic feet for seven hundred cubic feet or more beginning on and after January 1, 2004, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 45%.

That sewer rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system shall be \$5.39 per hundred cubic feet for the first three hundred cubic feet for sewer users beginning on and after January 1, 2005, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 10%.

That sewer rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system shall be \$7.01 per hundred cubic feet for more than three hundred cubic feet and less than seven hundred cubic feet beginning on and after January 1, 2005, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 25%.

That sewer rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system shall be \$9.22 per hundred cubic feet for seven hundred cubic feet or more beginning on and after January 1, 2005, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 43%.

That sewer rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system shall be \$5.93 per hundred cubic feet for the first three hundred cubic feet for sewer users beginning on and after January 1, 2006, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 10%.

That sewer rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system shall be \$8.20 per hundred cubic feet for more than three hundred cubic feet and less than seven hundred cubic feet beginning on and after January 1, 2006, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 17%.



That sewer rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system shall be \$10.88 per hundred cubic feet for seven hundred cubic feet or more beginning on and after January 1, 2006, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 18%.

That sewer rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system shall be \$6.52 per hundred cubic feet for the first three hundred cubic feet for sewer users beginning on and after January 1, 2007, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 10%.

That sewer rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system shall be \$9.10 per hundred cubic feet for more than three hundred cubic feet and less than seven hundred cubic feet beginning on and after January 1, 2007, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 11%.

That sewer rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system shall be \$12.08 per hundred cubic feet for seven hundred cubic feet or more beginning on and after January 1, 2007, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 11%.

That sewer rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system shall be \$7.04 per hundred cubic feet for the first three hundred cubic feet for sewer users beginning on and after January 1, 2008, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 8%.

That sewer rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system shall be \$9.83 per hundred cubic feet for more than three hundred cubic feet and less than seven hundred cubic feet beginning on and after January 1, 2008, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 8%.

That sewer rates for domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta system shall be \$13.29 per hundred cubic feet for seven hundred cubic feet or more beginning on and after January 1, 2008, with the effective rate increase for this usage level being 10%.

**SECTION 3: That Chapter 154, Article III, Division 3 (Water Rates, Charges, and Related Matters), Section 154-111 and 154-112 be amended to increase monthly Wholesale Water Rates as follows:**

That the Wholesale Water Rate be changed from the current rate of \$1.00 per hundred cubic feet to a rate of \$1.52 per hundred cubic feet for wholesale customers beginning on and after January 1, 2004.

That the Wholesale Water Rate shall be \$2.26 per hundred cubic feet for wholesale customers beginning on and after January 1, 2005.



That the Wholesale Water Rate shall be \$2.64 per hundred cubic feet for wholesale customers beginning on and after January 1, 2006.

That the Wholesale Water Rate shall be \$2.93 per hundred cubic feet for wholesale customers beginning on and after January 1, 2007.

That the Wholesale Water Rate shall be \$3.19 per hundred cubic feet for wholesale customers beginning on and after January 1, 2008.

**SECTION 4:** That effective January 1, 2009 for all billing cycles beginning on and after January 1, 2009 and for each year thereafter, water and sewer rates shall be increased based on the Consumer Price Index or other appropriate index for the preceding period not to exceed three percent (3%) per annum.

**SECTION 5:** That the City of Atlanta shall aggressively evaluate and pursue financial structuring options, restructuring of billing distribution and operational cost-saving measures to reduce the cost of the projected capital improvements program, as well as seek additional funds from other sources. In the event of reduction in the financing or other costs, growth rates that exceed projections, or the receipt by the City of Atlanta of additional funds, which are specifically and solely designated for use by the City of Atlanta for the purposes of funding the specified system improvements to maintain and upgrade the water treatment and distribution system and wastewater treatment and collection system to meet federal and state regulations and the future demands of economic growth in the City, the water and sewer rates increase ordained herein shall be reduced accordingly as allowed by local, state and federal law. In any event, the water and sewer rates shall be reviewed annually and accordingly revised and recalculated so as to reduce the rates for all metered customers in appropriate proportion.

**SECTION 6:** The Mayor or her designee shall provide to the City Council on a quarterly basis, in writing, a status and progress report before the Finance Committee and the City Utilities Committee, a status and progress report specifically detailing the efforts and initiatives undertaken by the City to reduce the burden on ratepayers through (1) value engineering activities, (2) collection of delinquent in-city and inter-jurisdictional accounts, (3) fine-tuning the appropriate allocation of fees based on actual usage by ratepayers, (4) lobbying efforts with local, state and federal sources, and (5) receipt of funds from other sources.

**SECTION 7:** That Chapter 154, Article III, Division 3 (Water Rates, Charges, and Related Matters), Section 154-118 be amended to create a security surcharge as follows:

(a) That the imposition of a surcharge shall be placed on all domestic, commercial, industrial and other users of the City of Atlanta Water and Wastewater System to pay for the cost to implement the security and infrastructure requirements as described in the Safe Drinking Water Act and Public Health Security and Bioterrorism Preparedness and Response Act.



(b) That for purpose of this ordinance, the surcharge will be described as the "Water and Wastewater Systems Security Surcharge."

(c) That the Water and Wastewater Systems Security Surcharge shall be \$0.15 per hundred cubic feet for all billing cycles beginning on and after January 1, 2004.

Funds

collected from the surcharge shall be deposited in a fund separate and distinct from other funds of the Water and Wastewater System.

**SECTION 8:** That funds generated by the Water and Wastewater Systems Security Surcharge shall only be used for the purpose of:

(a) The reduction of City of Atlanta Water System vulnerabilities which may substantially disrupt the ability of the treatment works to safely and reliably operate; or have a substantial adverse effect on critical infrastructure, public health or safety, or the environment;

(b) The purchase and installation of equipment for access control, intrusion prevention and delay, and detection of intruders and hazardous or dangerous substances,

(c) Security improvements to electronic, computer, or other automated systems and remote security systems, including controlling access to such systems, intrusion detection and prevention, and system backup;

(d) Participation in training programs and the purchase of training manuals and guidance materials relating to security; and

(e) Security screening of employees or contractor support services.

**SECTION 9:** That the Water and Wastewater Systems Security Surcharge hereby established shall terminate and shall not be applicable to billings rendered from and after January 1, 2011 unless extended by ordinance adopted by the city council.

**SECTION 10:** That the conservation and affordability base rate established for the first three hundred cubic feet shall constitute the minimum billed charge per month for all metered customers and shall increase as set forth above.

**SECTION 11:** That all ordinances or parts in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.
