AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 2-308 (B) (II) AND (V) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, SO AS TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF ASSISTANTS FOR THE OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT OF COUNCIL FROM FIVE (5) TO THREE (3); TO REDUCE THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE SALARIES OF THE ASSISTANTS FOR THE OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT IN THE 2004 GENERAL FUND BUDGET FROM \$170,000 TO \$102,000; TO PROVIDE THAT THE \$68,000 IN SALARY SAVINGS REALIZED FROM SAID STAFF REDUCTION AND DECREASE IN THE 2004 GENERAL FUND BUDGET BE TRANSFERRED FUND, ACCOUNT AND CENTER: 1A01 GENERAL FUND, 724001-CONSULTANT, PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FEE, C21099-SHARED SUPPORT; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA HEREBY
ORDAINS as follows:

Section 1: That Section 2-308 (b) (ii) of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Atlanta, Georgia which reads:

“(ii) Number of assistants; salaries. The President shall be entitled to employ up to five senior city council assistants or up to five special city council assistants and such other city council assistants as deemed necessary. Each such employee shall be paid on an hourly or salary basis, as determined by the President, provided the aggregate compensation on behalf all such employees, including the cost of any benefits provided by the city, shall not exceed the total of the amount appropriated for such purpose plus any amount carried over from previous years in accordance with subsection (e). No more than five employees of whatever category of each shall be entitled to benefits.”

Be amended to read:

“(ii) Number of assistants; salaries. The President shall be entitled to employ up to **three (3)** senior city council assistants or up to **three (3)** special city council assistants and such other city council assistants as deemed necessary. Each such employee shall be paid on an hourly or salary basis, as determined by the President, provided the aggregate compensation on behalf all such employees, including the cost of any benefits provided by the city, shall not exceed the total of the amount appropriated for such purpose plus any amount carried over from previous years in accordance with subsection (e). No more than **three (3)** employees of whatever category of each shall be entitled to benefits.”



Section 2: That Section 2-308 (b) (v) which reads:

“(v) Annual appropriation for salaries. The amount of \$170,000.00 shall be appropriated annually for the salaries of the assistants authorized in this section, and the cost of insurance or other benefits provided to such employees shall not be charged to such amount. The amount of annual appropriation shall be increased by the appropriate pro rata amount necessary to equal the average amount of any salary increases given to city employees in any given year.”

Be hereby amended by reducing the amount of the annual appropriation for the salaries of said assistants from “\$170,000 to \$102,000, so that when amended the new subsection shall read:

“(v) Annual appropriation for salaries. The amount of \$102,000.00 shall be appropriated annually for the salaries of the assistants authorized in this section, and the cost of insurance or other benefits provided to such employees shall not be charged to such amount. The amount of annual appropriation shall be increased by the appropriate pro rata amount necessary to equal the average amount of any salary increases given to city employees in any given year.”

Section 3: That the \$68,000 in salary savings realized from said staff reduction and decrease in the 2004 General Fund budget shall be handled in the following manner:

Section 4: That \$61,842 Appropriations Payable Carry Forward in Salaries and Operating Expenditures be transferred to Shared Support

TRANSFER FROM APPROPRIATIONS

1A01 711001 C11001 President of Council Salaries \$53,656.00

1A01 72xxxx C11001 President of Council Operating Expense \$ 8,186.00

TRANSFER TO APPROPRIATIONS

1A01 724001 C21099 Shared Support - Consultant/Professional Services \$61,842.00

Section 5: That the \$61,842.00 identified in Section 4 be expended as reviewed by the Committee on Council and authorized by the Full Council.

Section 6: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
