**A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE EQUITABLE
DISTRIBUTION OF SPLOST AUTHORITY AND
REVENUE.**

WHEREAS, current state special purpose local option sales tax (SPLOST) law does not provide municipalities with an equal voice over either the call for a SPLOST or the distribution of revenue from the sales tax; and

WHEREAS, we want them to amend the SPLOST law to give cities equal access to funding; and

WHEREAS, cities don't want veto power, we want Equal Power, just like LOST; and

WHEREAS, counties have had veto power over city projects for over 18 years; and

WHEREAS, today's SPLOST relationships are but one election away from changing; and

WHEREAS, cities want SPLOST referendums to pass, not fail, and will work to that end; and

WHEREAS, the hammer for working out agreements in LOST should also work in SPLOST; and

WHEREAS, this is too important for the General Assembly not to address this year; and

WHEREAS, residents of Georgia's cities deserve a fair share of SPLOST authority and revenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, as follows:

Section 1: That the 2004 Georgia General Assembly is urged to provide Georgia's municipalities with distribution of SPLOST revenue.

Section 2: That the Municipal Clerk is hereby directed to forward copies of this Resolution to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor and all members of the 2004 Georgia General Assembly.
