

**A SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE**

**04-O-0216**

**BY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE**

**AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING APPROPRIATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,036,795.26 FROM AND TO VARIOUS ACCOUNTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACQUIRING LAND FOR GREENSPACE PROJECTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 01-0-1697, adopted by the Council on November 19, 2001, and approved by the Mayor on November 27, 2001, allocated FY2001 Georgia Greenspace (Fulton) grant funds to various accounts to cover the cost of land acquisition for parks and greenspace in certain project areas around the City of Atlanta, and listed project area priorities for Year 1 and Year 2; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has FY2002 Georgia Greenspace Program fees available, as of January 23, 2004, in the amount of \$2,421,349.53; and

**WHEREAS**, FY2001 and FY2002 Georgia Greenspace Program grant funds have an expenditure deadline of June 30, 2004 and June 10, 2004 respectively; and

**WHEREAS**, projects identified in Year 1 project areas have been completed and have funds remaining in project accounts; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Planning and Community Development, Bureau of Planning and the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Cultural Affairs, Bureau of Parks have identified additional priority projects for Year 2, throughout the City (Exhibit A) that will be able to meet the expenditure deadline; and

**WHEREAS**, The Conservation Fund and The Trust for Public Land have agreed to assist the City of Atlanta in the acquisition and preservation of Georgia Greenspace Program properties by working with (1) the Department of Planning and Community Development and the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Cultural Affairs and (2) the present owners of such properties; and

**WHEREAS**, the owner of the Greene Property, listed in Exhibit A, has offered to sell the property at a Bargain Sale, significantly below an estimated Fair Market Value, conditioned upon having the property named in his honor; Herbert W. Greene, Sr. Nature Preserve; and

**WHEREAS**, both FY2002 funds and the funds transferred from completed Year 1 project accounts will be used to fund Year 2 projects.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:** That the Chief Financial Officer transfer funds from and to various project accounts as follows:

**SECTION 2:** That the City of Atlanta hereby establishes the projects listed in Exhibit A Section 1 as priorities projects for acquisition; and that projects listed in Exhibit A Section 2 will replace any project in Section 1 for lack of purchase.

**SECTION 3:** That the Mayor or her designee is hereby authorized to enter into negotiations with property owners to purchase, trade, or transfer real property, throughout the City of Atlanta, as listed and described in Exhibit A, at a price no greater than the property's Fair Market Value.

**SECTION 4:** That in the event the Greene Property listed in Exhibit A is acquired, it shall hereby be named the Herbert W. Greene, Sr. Nature Preserve.

**SECTION 5:** That Fund Account Center Number 1B02-774001-Y63D1017KT0, Greenspace Multiple Projects, is to be used for the payment of charges, including but not limited to surveys, environmental assessments, appraisals, title reports, title insurance, and other closing costs, but excluding consultant service fees, as required by the funding source, in an amount not to exceed \$3,036,795.26.

**SECTION 6:** That the Mayor or her designee is hereby authorized to obtain surveys, title reports, and appraisals and to establish just compensation thereon to be offered to the property owners.

**SECTION 7:** That the requirements of City Code Section 2-1541 (d) of the Procurement and Real Estate Code are waived to allow the purchase of property on behalf of the City without further authorization of City Council.

**SECTION 8:** That the City's Greenspace Acquisition Consultant, US Infrastructure, Inc., is authorized to settle those acquisitions of property at an amount authorized by the Chief Procurement Officer.

**SECTION 9:** That in the event that the Mayor or her designee is unable to agree upon a purchase price for a property listed in Exhibit A that is greater than the property's Fair Market Value, and is able to agree upon all other terms of the purchase, the City is hereby authorized to acquire this property in fee simple for the purpose of maintaining the property as a public park.

**SECTION 10:** That in the event negotiations with the affected property owners fail, or the Mayor or her designee believes that a property owner may attempt to sell the property to another buyer, the City Attorney is hereby authorized to use all means necessary and within his/her power, up to and including Condemnation to acquire the necessary real property interests; and, the City Attorney is authorized to engage in the services of outside counsel, where necessary, to handle Condemnation proceedings and pay for such services without further authorization from City Council.

**SECTION 11:** That in addition to legally required due diligence documents, the transaction for each parcel acquired with funds allocated in Section 1 shall include the following:

- Phase I environmental assessment
- Complete boundary survey
- Title Insurance

**SECTION 12:** That upon acquisition, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Cultural Affairs, Bureau of Parks, is hereby charged with all responsibility for properties purchased with funds allocated in Section 1; and that the deed for each tract shall provide that such properties shall remain permanently preserved as greenspace with passive recreation for the benefit of the public.

**SECTION 13:** That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.





**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2001 GENERAL GOVERNMENT CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND BY \$2,914,000.00 AND THE 2001 INTERGOVERNMENTAL GRANT FUND BY \$2,068,492.00 FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$4,982,492.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF FUNDING GREENSPACE PROJECTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, Ordinance 01-O-0833, adopted by the City Council and approved by the Mayor in June, 2001, anticipated and appropriated \$2,677,143 for the Georgia Greenspace Program (Fulton County), and \$191,349 for the Georgia Greenspace Program (DeKalb County); and

WHEREAS, the City has Georgia Greenspace Program fees available, as of September 19, 2001, in the amount of \$1,877,143; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 94-R-1424, adopted by the City Council and approved by the Mayor in September, 1994, establishes policies for the use of park impact fee revenues; and

WHEREAS, the City has park impact fee revenues available, as of August 31, 2001, in the amount of \$2,921,764; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to use these Georgia Greenspace Program funds and park impact fee revenues in the amount of \$4,982,492 to fund the acquisition of certain park and greenspace properties;

WHEREAS, the City wishes to establish policies for the maintenance, operation, and development of such properties; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to establish priorities for the acquisition of greenspace properties;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1:** That the City of Atlanta hereby establishes the projects listed in Exhibit A and shown in Exhibit B as priorities for acquisition and that, as acquisition funds become available, they shall be allocated to these projects.

**SECTION 2:** That the projects listed in Exhibit C are hereby funded for acquisition.

**SECTION 3:** That the 2001 (General Government Capital Outlay Fund) Budget be and is hereby amended as follows:

- Phase I environmental assessment
- Complete boundary survey.

**SECTION 6:** That site-specific master plans, as necessary, shall be completed within five years of parcel acquisition.

**SECTION 7:** That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.




