**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING RECIPROCAL FARE TRANSFER BETWEEN THE METROPOLITAN ATLANTA RAPID TRANSIT AUTHORITY (MARTA) AND THE GEORGIA REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY (GRTA) PROVIDED SUCH AGREEMENT FURTHER REQUIRES THAT THE STATE OF GEORGIA PROVIDE FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR MARTA**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta recognizes the critical nature of air quality and congestion mitigation efforts in the metropolitan region; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta also recognizes the importance of mass transit in accomplishing those goals and the significance of providing a seamless transportation option for the Citizens of Atlanta and the metropolitan region; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta recognizes the importance of a reciprocal fare transfer agreement between MARTA and GRTA and the benefit to be derived from such an agreement by the citizens of the City of Atlanta, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta recognizes that the citizens of the City of Atlanta, DeKalb County and Fulton County, having recognized the importance of mass transit, have invested in MARTA for over twenty-five years and have created with their tax dollars the core and hub of a regional system and further that GRTA regional bus service may require additional costs to MARTA and thus the citizens of the City of Atlanta, DeKalb and Fulton counties in order to accommodate GRTA buses and passengers; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA;** supports a reciprocal fare transfer agreement between MARTA and The GRTA Regional Express Bus Service provided such agreement requires that the State of Georgia, through its agency, GRTA will provide financial support to MARTA, whether by capital program support or direct operational subsidies.
