



ORDINANCE BY H. LAMAR WILLIS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 98-1 OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ADD PARKING ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AS SPECIAL POLICE OFFICERS, AND PROVIDING FOR AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 98-1 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances, the Chief of Police or a designee has authority to appoint special police officers who have the power, among other things, to issue citations and summonses for the violation of, or failure to comply with, any section of the Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Atlanta to have Parking Enforcement Officers employed within the Department of Public Works to enforce parking regulations within the City of Atlanta; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA

Section One: Section 98-1(d) of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances, entitled "Special police officers" is amended in the following particulars, as indicated by the underlined text:

(d) Special officers shall include only fire inspectors, health inspectors for Fulton and DeKalb Counties, sanitary code enforcement officers, sanitary route supervisors, city hall parking lot attendants, building inspectors, plumbing inspectors, zoning inspectors, inspectors for the site development coordinator of the department of public works, parking enforcement officers for the department of public works, housing code inspectors, codes compliance inspectors, taxicab inspectors, the director, bureau of taxicabs and vehicles for hire and administrative assistants within that bureau, corrections officers, water quality control specialists and inspectors for the department of water and industrial waste inspectors for the bureau of pollution control.

Section Two: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed.

Section Three: This Ordinance shall become effective IMMEDIATELY after final reading and adoption.
