A RESOLUTION TO EXPRESS THE INTENT OF THE ATLANTA CITY COUNCIL TO ESTABLISH A CITY OF ATLANTA HUMAN RIGHTS AWARD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta and the City of Nuremberg, Germany, are Sister Cities; and

**WHEREAS**, both cities, sharing a common culture of Civil Rights and Human Rights, have made great contribution to advancing world peace and harmony; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Nuremberg, Germany, has instituted an International Human Rights Award; and

**WHEREAS**, the award is given every two years and is intended to honor individuals or groups, who have dedicated and committed themselves, in an exemplary manner, to the advancement and respect of Human Rights; and

**WHEREAS**, in bestowing the Nuremberg International Human Rights Award, the City of Nuremberg is making a powerful statement about its citizens' unwavering belief in and strong support for fundamental Human Rights for all peoples; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta is home to the King Center and Carter Presidential Center, which embrace Dr. King's and President Carter's visions of a world where nonviolence and human rights are observed and respected; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Atlanta recognizes and respects the inherent dignity of all members of the human family; and

**WHEREAS**, the Atlanta City Council wishes to initiate an effort to participate in the promotion of universal respect for and observance of human rights.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA, that** the Atlanta City Council hereby expresses the desire and intent to establish a City of Atlanta Human Rights Award, which is intended to symbolize the City's strong commitment to human rights and basic liberties.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Advisory Committee on International Relations will create a selection committee consisting of representatives from its Level One Membership and representatives from the Carter Presidential Center and the King Center for Non-Violent Change.
