AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HER DESIGNEE
TO PURSUE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED
STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS TO
PARTNER WITH THE CITY OF ATLANTA IN THE
ASSESSMENT AND EXECUTION OF PROJECTS IN
THE CLEAN WATER ATLANTA PROGRAM

WHEREAS, in September 1994, the U.S. House of Representatives Committee on Public Works and Transportation passed Resolution 2445 (introduced by Congressman John Lewis), authorizing the Secretary of the Army to conduct a study of the Georgia Metro-Atlanta Watersheds; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this legislation is to provide technical and funding assistance to communities to address flooding, water quality, and environmental problems associated with stormwater runoff; and

WHEREAS, this legislation enables the US Army Corps of engineers (USACE) to enter into cost-sharing agreements with local governments and provide reconnaissance and feasibility studies for watersheds; and

WHEREAS, all water resources watershed studies undertaken by the USACE are conducted in two-phases, 1) the Reconnaissance Phase and 2) the Feasibility Phase. The Reconnaissance Phase Study can be fully federally funded. The feasibility phase, as authorized in the Water Resources Development Act of 1986 is cost shared 50 percent Federal and 50 percent by the non-Federal sponsor; and


WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta has just awarded a contract to Brown & Caldwell for an assessment of watersheds for this same purpose; and

WHEREAS, many projects listed in the Clean Water Atlanta program are stormwater related, including, but not limited to, the CSO consent decree projects; and

WHEREAS, all projects determined by the USACE to be eligible may be federally funded up to 65% of the construction cost; and

WHEREAS, this reduction of cost could provide the Atlanta ratepayers with substantial rate reductions over current projections; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA; that the Mayor or her designee (Commissioner of Watershed Management) is hereby authorized to begin negotiations with the US Army Corps of Engineers to enlist their participation in performing watershed studies and identifying for



potential federal participation for construction “environmental infrastructure and resource protection needs”, including “environmental quality, water quality, water supply, and flood damage reduction.”

AND FINALLY, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
