



In 1986-1987, she served as law clerk to Judge James Dickson Phillips of the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit.

Teresa serves on the Executive Committee of the State Bar of Georgia's Appellate Section and the ABA Council of Appellate Lawyers. She is also a member of the Litigation, Individual Rights and Responsibilities, and Judicial Administration Sections of the American Bar Association. She serves on the Board of Directors of the American Constitution Society, Leadership Georgia, The Howard School and The Children's School and is a member of Radcliffe Presbyterian Church. In 1999, Governor Roy

Barnes appointed her to serve on Georgia's Judicial Nominating Committee. In 2001, she began a six-year term as a member of the State Bar of Georgia's Board of Bar Examiners. In 2002, Teresa was appointed to the Board of Advisors for the Center for Civil Rights at the University of North Carolina. She also serves on the Supreme Court Historic Society's Publication Committee.

Teresa is a frequent speaker at local and national seminars. Teresa was a speaker at the Appellate Strategies Seminar where her topic was "Emergency Motions, Injunctions and Stays at the Appellate Level." Teresa has given televised presentations on the Clean Water Act and on trial techniques. She also served on a panel on Benefits and Challenges in the New Federal Courts ADR Act the American Bar Association's annual meeting in 1999. Recently, Teresa served as a presenter on a panel on race and affirmative action at the Constitution Under Clinton Program at Duke University. She has been a guest on CNN's Burden of Proof, Larry King Live, Fox News and MSNBC as an expert on questions of constitutional law.
