AN AMENDED ORDINANCE BY COMMITTEE ON COUNCIL

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2001 CITY OF ATLANTA
PRECINCT AND POLLING PLACES IN PRECINCTS 01T, 07F,
07J, 08P, 12C1, 12C2 AND 12F; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the 2001 Precinct and Polling Place Ordinance, dated October 24, 2001, was adopted November 5, 2001, and;

WHEREAS, such Precinct and Polling Place Ordinance has previously been amended by action of the City Council on May 20, 2002; July 15, 2002; September 3, 2002; October 21, 2002; November 18, 2002; September 15, 2003; and October 20, 2003.

WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board of Registrations and Elections has authorized relocations and/or re-designations of Precincts/Polling Places 01T, 07F, 07J, 08P, 12C1, 12C2 and 12F to requested and/or necessary changes; and

WHEREAS, all affected voters either have been or will be notified of these changes by the Fulton County Office of Registrations and Elections accordingly, and;

WHEREAS, the governing authority of the City of Atlanta, the Atlanta City Council believes that ratification of these previously authorized changes should be made by this Body.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the Atlanta City Council does hereby ratify the previous authorization and approval by the Fulton County Board of Registrations and Elections of the relocations and/or redesignations of Precincts/Polling Places 01T, 07F, 07J, 08P, 12C1, 12C2 and 12F within the City of Atlanta.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Atlanta City Council does hereby Amend the 2001 Precinct and Polling Place Ordinance, dated October 24, 2001, and Adopted November 5, 2001 which was codified as Section 66-2 of the City of Atlanta Code of Ordinances and adopted by reference, by adding the recent changes to Precincts/Polling Places 01T, 07F, 07J, 08P, 12C1, 12C2 and 12F all of which are incorporated into the March 1, 2004 Revision to the 2001 Precinct and Polling Place Ordinance identified as Attachment I to this ordinance, with certain particular changes described by the further attachments identified as Exhibits A, B, C and D all being made a part hereof and noted as follows:

SECTION 1. To amend Precinct/Polling Place 01T, located at; Benteen Elementary School, 200 Casanova Street, S.E., by temporarily relocating said Precinct 01T to Church of Atlanta Lighthouse, Inc., 1380 Boulevard S.E., due to scheduled renovations of the existing facility. The proposed facility is accessible to the handicapped and is approximately two blocks away from the existing facility, as indicated by the attachment identified as Exhibit A, (Pages 1-3). The changes regarding Precinct 01T are noted within Attachment I to this ordinance.




SECTION 2. To amend Precincts/Polling Places 07F and 07J temporarily located jointly at; Cathedral of St. Philip, 2744 Peachtree Road, N.W., by removing the joint designation of said precincts and having Precinct/Polling Place 07F to remain located at Cathedral of St. Philip, 2744 Peachtree Road, N.W., and by relocating said Precinct/Polling Place 07J to its permanent location at Peachtree Hills Recreation Center, 308 Peachtree Hills Avenue, N.E. due to completed renovations at that facility. The proposed facility is accessible to the handicapped and is approximately 1 mile away from the existing facility, as indicated by the attachment identified as Exhibit B, (Pages 1-4). The changes regarding Precinct 07J are noted within Attachment I to this ordinance.

SECTION 3. To amend Precinct/Polling Place 08P located at; The Water Works Lodge, 655 Green Street, N.W., by relocating said Precinct to Institute of Paper Science & Technology Conference Center, 555 14th Street, N.W. due to scheduled renovations at the existing facility (there is no suitable facility located within the boundaries of the precinct). The proposed facility is accessible to the handicapped and is approximately 1.5 miles away from the existing facility, as indicated by the attachment identified as Exhibit C, (Pages 1-3). The changes regarding Precinct 08P are noted within Attachment I to this ordinance.

SECTION 4. To amend Precincts/Polling Places 12C1 and 12C2 located jointly at; Sylvan Hills Middle School Annex, 1757 Melrose Drive, S.W., by relocating joint Precincts/Polling Places 12C1 and 12C2 to Sylvan Hills Middle School, 1461 Sylvan Road, S.W., due to notification that a federally funded program housed in the existing facility (Head Start Program) cannot be involved in any activity relating to voting. The proposed facility is accessible to the handicapped and is approximately 1 mile away from the existing facility, as indicated by the attachment identified as Exhibit B, (Pages 1, 5-6). The changes regarding Joint Precincts 12C1 and 12C2 are noted within Attachment I to this ordinance.

SECTION 5. To amend Precinct/Polling Place 12F located at; Brewer Elementary School, 2352 Bagwell Drive, S.W., by relocating said Precinct to John Birdine Neighborhood Facility, 215 Lakewood Way, S.W., due to closing of the existing facility. The proposed facility is accessible to the handicapped and is approximately 1 mile away from the existing facility, as indicated by the attachment identified as Exhibit D, (Pages 1-3). The changes regarding Precinct 12F are noted within Attachment I to this ordinance.

SECTION 6. That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.












