AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE 2004 (INTERGOVERNMENTAL GRANT FUND) BUDGET BY ADDING TO ANTICIPATIONS AND APPROPRIATIONS AN AMOUNT OF TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS AND NO CENTS (\$10,000.00), FOR A COMPUTER RECYCLING GRANT, FROM THE DELL COMPUTER CORPORATION, INTENDED FOR A ONE-DAY COMPUTER RECYCLING EVENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta currently does not offer electronic recycling for City residents, and

WHEREAS, the grant program is an evolution of Dell's National Recycling Tour which has collected almost 2 million pounds of unwanted computer equipment to date, and

WHEREAS, the City participated in the Dell recycling event in 2003 in which 74 tons of computer material was collected, and

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide this service to City residents to decrease the amount of electronic waste that is deposited in landfills, and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta was selected by Dell as a grantee along with 12 other entities around the country.

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of the City of Atlanta, Georgia, recommends increasing estimated receipts in the Intergovernmental Grant Fund Budget by \$10,000;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA AS FOLLOWS:
