A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT FUNDING FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE PROJECT SAFE NEIGHBORHOOD INITIATIVE TO EXPAND THE WEED AND SEED INTENSIVE SURVEILLANCE OFFICERS PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Department of Justice has funded the Weed and Seed Intensive Surveillance Officers program for the purpose of providing intensive intervention services to youth who are adjudicated delinquent and to their families, to prevent further penetration into the juvenile or criminal court systems targeting the Project Safe Neighborhoods communities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta has been notified of the possibility of additional funding; and

WHEREAS, the City of Atlanta wishes to continue this program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ATLANTA, GEORGIA as follows:

Section 1: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for and accept grant funds from the Department of Justice in an amount not to exceed (\$225,560) two hundred twenty-five thousand five hundred and sixty dollars to be paid from 1A01 761001 T31001.

General Fund (1A01) Account Payment to Other Government (761001) Unallocated Fund – Wide Expenses (T31001)

Section 2: That the Mayor is authorized to enter into any necessary grant agreements.
