WHEREAS, the Georgia International Law Enforcement Exchange was established to support international cooperation among law enforcement executives to combat terrorism, and

WHEREAS, the threat of international terrorism remains a serious concern to public safety personnel throughout the United States, and

WHEREAS, to prepare for and effectively prevent acts of terrorism, law enforcement executives with the Atlanta Police Department must collaborate with peers at home and abroad to remain abreast of the degree and nature of terrorist threats from both international and domestic groups and individuals

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
ATLANTA, GEORGIA**

Section one: that the Mayor is authorized to apply for and accept a grant from the Governor's Criminal Justice Coordinating Council in the amount of \$4,125 and to be matched with no more than \$1,375.00 from the General Fund Budget

Section two: that sufficient matching funds are available in the Non-Departmental Section of the 2004 General Fund Budget, in fund account center 1A01 562001 T31001, the General Fund Interfund Transfer account in the Non-Departmental section of the General Fund Budget.
