- 07-O-1900 (15) An Ordinance by Councilmember Kwanza Hall **as substituted by Public Safety and Legal Administration Committee** to amend Chapter 10, Sections 10-1, 10-60(a)(1)(c) and 10-129 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Atlanta so as to provide new requirements for Wine Tasting Events to be held on the premises of licensed Wine Specialty Shops; and for other purposes. **(Councilmember Smith made a motion to approve on substitute.)**




